The following questions have been received:

**Question:** Is the Railroad safety plan, and additional insurance requirements to be considered incidental to a pay item, or will the department be issuing a separate line item for this provision?

**Response:** The Railroad safety plan and additional insurance requirements will be considered incidental to contract items.

**Question:** Due to existing construction contract between Abbot and Greenville, and the possibility of up to 4 lane simultaneous lane closures; could lead to wait times of up to 40 minutes per truck. Due to the long distance from the supply source; would the department consider extending the completion date of this contract to allow coordination with the ongoing project; to minimize the amount of time the trucks are waiting in construction?

**Response:** No, the Department is not changing the Contract dates at this time.

**Question:** In the contract bid book it mentions that Contractors Pollution Liability for \$2mm is required and at the end of the paragraph it indicates that " IF APPLICABLE -DEPENDS ON SCOPE OF WORK BEING PERFORMED-CONFIRM WITH RISK MANAGEMENT". This information was highlighted in the electronic PDF of the contract bid book downloaded from the DOT Website. Can you please clarify if necessary? Thank you

**Response:** It will be the Contractor's responsibility to coordinate with the Railroad after contract award regarding the Railroad's insurance requirements for this contract.
