The following questions have been received:

Question: Is there a prebid?

Response: No. Contractor may visit the site when they wish after calling Brian Haynes at 441-1729 to give a heads up so that the crew at that location will be aware.

Question: Are there any civil plans?

Response: No

Question: Where does the foundation drain daylight to?

Response: It will come off the back left corner of the building, run approximately 75 feet and end over the bank at the edge of the property.

Question: Does the electric need to be bid underground or overhead? Looks like the E line on the drawings goes through the existing loading ramp.

Response: Underground and will have to go around the loading ramp.

Question: Do bollard get painted or sleeved?

Response: Contractor's option. Bollard specs are on page 7 of the Plan Set. If painted, entire bollard that is visible after install must be painted. If sleeved, the sleeve must cover the entire visible portion of the bollard.

Question: Is there an overhead door? I see it noted on electrical but no other information

Response: Yes, all information pertaining to the overhead door is in the bid book. Page 73 of the Bid Book contains Special Provisions for the overhead door. Pages 7, 8, 12, and 13 of the Plan Set have various instructions for the overhead door.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on May 14, 2025.
