Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

CHANGE on page 11, in the “**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**”, the bid opening date in the first paragraph from “February 4, 2026” to read “**February 18, 2026**”. Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

Question: We are interested in bidding on the Medway and Eddington Crew Quarters Buildings projects that bid on 2/4 @ 11AM. However, we have prior commitments for estimating and would not be able to provide pricing unless the bid date was extended to either 2/12 or 2/19, so we are requesting a bid extension. Please let us know if this will be possible so we can enter the work into our queue.

Response: The Department will extend the bid opening to February 18, 2026

Question: We are intending on bidding 4 MDOT Crew Quarters Buildings. Is it possible to stagger the dates and a 2-week extension to properly solicit subcontractors for all 4 projects.

Response: The Department will extend the bid opening to February 18, 2026

Question: Is there a scheduled site visit or walk-through for any of these projects?

Response: There will be no site visit or walk-through conducted. The Bidders can visit each location Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00am & 3:30pm.

Question: Is there a proposed budget for each individual project?

Response: Government estimates are not provided.

Question: Does the contractor own paying for the building permit?

Response: The Department is not required to obtain building permits. The Department has let the municipalities know of the proposed projects, but the bidder(s) are responsible for all other permits required to carry out the project, example: electrical/plumbing others.

Question: Is the contractor responsible for Builders Risk?

Response: Please refer to the Maine Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, *March 2020 Edition*: Section 110- Indemnification, Bonding, and Insurance, (pages 1-118 -1-122)

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **February 18, 2026**.
