Question: Please clarify – Exterior signage is owner furnished / owner installed?

Response: No exterior signage is needed for this project.

Question: Summary 1.7.D Says access through Ordway Drive, please clarify?

Response: Please ignore this statement

Question: Are there Versant excess charges?

Response: Sorry we do not know the answer to this. The department will have the electrical to the disconnect on the existing building already completed.

Question: Can you provide material spec for floor polish treatment & stain.

Response: Specification 033543 provides this information

Question: Can you provide spec for CMU locker base?

Response: Provide CMU locker base per metal locker manufacturers' recommendations.

Question: Can you provide spec for foundation damp proofing

Response: Provide Tremco Museal spray applied damp proofing or equal.

Question: Page 5 note 20 mentions room signage, see none. Please clarify

Response: Delete note 20, no signage required.

Question: Page 20 Foundation note 1 seems to be directing the GC to retain a Geotech engineer to verify existing soil conditions. Please clarify

Response: Contractor to retain a Geotechnical Engineer if substandard soils are discovered during foundation excavation

Question: page 20 Foundation note 7 says we must wait 28 days before backfilling foundation walls. Please confirm

Response: Incorrect, it should state; 7 days before backfilling foundation walls.

Question: age 20 Foundation note 5 calls for 12" min. structural fill under slab. Page 11, detail/section 1 says 6", please clarify

Response: Provide 12" min. structural fill below new concrete slab
