Dear Sir/Ms.:

Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

**CHANGE** on page 22, "APPENDIX A, Description of Materials, Supplies, Equipment and Bid Price", in the section "Delivery", the last sentence which begins with "The Department will not off-load the materials at the delivery site ..." to read, "**The MaineDOT will off-load the materials at the delivery site provided the Contractor has provided the MaineDOT the 48-hour notice specified in Appendix A.**" Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** Can you confirm that this is for supply and delivery of the generator only, and that no installation or concrete pad will be required by the supplier.

**Response:** This is for supply and delivery only.

**Question:** Under Appendix A, "Department will not off-load the materials at the delivery site" Is this firm? The generator would ship on an open flat truck, with no means to unload it. Therefore the supplier would have to hire an outside towing company to bring a large tow truck with a boom on the back to unload. Most tow companies would charge about \$500, which would be part of the bid price. Would the DOT be able to unload the generator using an overhead crane, forklift, or perhaps a backhoe / loader? Weight of the unit would be about 2800 lbs., and would have an overhead hook.

**Response:** See above changes. The Department will off-load the materials.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **September 23, 2020**.
