Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

On page 9, Notice to Contractors, in the first paragraph, **CHANGE** the last sentence that reads, "The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a bridge, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract." to read "The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size and scope to be considered for the award of this contract." Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

Question: We would like to know how strict the delivery timeline is for this project. Based on the proposed delivery date it would be hard to meet the project due date of 4 weeks after awarded the contract. This is mostly due to the time needed to hot dip galvanized coat all the steel tube for this project.

Response: The delivery time has been extended to 7 weeks as per Bid Amendment No. 1.

Question: Will there be any welding or other certifications need for this project?

Response: Standard Specification Section 504.04 will not apply to this project. No welding is required or permitted.
