Dear Sir/Ms:

As the Department has determined that there is NOT sufficient coverage of On-Call Services of the entire area being bid on, the Department has scheduled a second bid opening date which extends the advertisement period of this Contract. Any Bidders that have previously submitted Bids may choose **to** revise or **not to** revise their Bids. If the Bidder chooses to revise their Bid, they must resubmit a complete Bid Package which shall include a Bid and all other documents required in the Bid Documents and the original Bid will be returned to the Bidder. The Bid Package with the latest (newest) date shall replace all previously submitted packages. Refer to Special Provision Section 102 Bidding on page 29 of the Bid Book. The Bid Opening date for this contract has been extended to **January 25, 2023**.

Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

CHANGE on page 9, in the “**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**”, the bid opening date in the first paragraph from “January 11, 2023” to read” **January 25, 2023**”. Make this change in pen and ink.

The following question has been received:

Question Will the state provide water once our truck is out? The minimum is 100 gallons that will not last very long.

Response: Yes, The Department will provide water to the sweepers as needed. The Contractor may fill their water tanks at MaineDOT facilities.

Question: Will the State provide adequate dump truck to dump into?

Response: Yes, The Department will provide dump trucks and approved areas to dump as needed.

Question: Will the state provide an adequate person that knows the area and provide safe working area with signs where we need to sweep.

Response: Yes, you will be provided a competent person and signage by the MaineDOT facility in the area where the Work will take place.

Question: What is the maximum depth and width of sand or dirt that the state would require us to sweep up?

Response: There is no maximum depth or width. Any dirt/sand material on the paved surfaces shall be removed.
