As the Department has determined that there is NOT sufficient coverage of On-Call Services of the entire area being bid on, the Department has scheduled a second bid opening date which extends the advertisement period of this Contract. Any Bidders that have previously submitted Bids may choose **to** revise or **not to** revise their Bids. If the Bidder chooses to revise their Bid, they must resubmit a complete Bid Package including all other documents required. Upon request, the Bidder will have the original Bid returned to them otherwise it will be discarded. The Bid Package with the latest (newest) date shall replace all previously submitted packages. Refer to Special Provision Section 102 Bidding on page 56 of the Bid Book. The Bid Opening date for this contract has been extended to **January 15, 2025**.

Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

CHANGE on page 10, in the “**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**”, the bid opening date in the first paragraph from “December 18, 2024” to read “**January 15, 2025**”. Make this change in pen and ink.

The following question has (questions have) been received:

Question: Do items have to be bid with a dollar amount per unit? Can the items be bid cost plus or other ways?

Response: All items must be bid with a dollar amount. No other bid method (cost plus or others) will be allowed and will be considered an irregular bid. Irregular bids will be rejected.
