UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THE CONTRACT, THE COST OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACTOR'S PRICES FOR THE PAY ITEMS. THERE WILL BE NO SEPARATE PAYMENTS. INCIDENTAL WORK ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

BELOW GRADE UTILITY INFORMATION IS BASED ON INFORMATION PROVIDED BY EACH UTILITY. LOCATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES SHOWN IS ONLY APPROXIMATE AND MAY NOT BE COMPLETE. PRIVATE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SUCH AS. BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SEWER LINES, WATER LINES AND BURIED ELECTRICAL SERVICE ENTRANCES ARE NOT SHOWN. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASCERTAIN THE LOCATION AND SIZE OF EXISTING UTILITIES IN THE FIELD WITH THE RESPECTIVE UTILITY REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK. TEST PITS MAY BE REQUIRED. - 3. DO NOT SCALE DRAWINGS UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. EXISTING CONDITIONS BASED ON FIELD MEASUREMENTS BY WRIGHT-PIERCE AND AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY AS PROVIDED BY THE MAINE OFFICE OF GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS. ALL PLAN DIMENSIONS AND LOCATIONS ARE APPROXIMATE.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY LAYOUT WITH THE OWNER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE OWNER, UTILITIES, AND OTHERS AS REQUIRED BY THE CONTRACT, INCLUDING RELATED QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTIONS.
- . THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR RESETTING ALL EXISTING PROPERTY MONUMENTATION THAT IS DISTURBED BY HIS OPERATIONS AT NO EXPENSE TO THE OWNER. THIS WORK IS TO BE DONE BY A LAND SURVEYOR REGISTERED IN THE STATE OF MAINE.
- ANY VALVE BOX TOPS LOCATED IN THE GRANITE RUMBLE STRIP SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO GRADE, AND ALL OTHER MANHOLES, VALVE BOXES AND OTHER BURIED FACILITES WITH SURFACE ACCESS SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO MATCH FINAL GRADES, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. MANHOLES AND CATCH BASINS ARE 4 FEET IN DIAMETER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. THE TOP OF THE MANHOLE FRAMES SHALL BE SET FLUSH WITH FINISH GRADE. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE ALL UTILITY RELOCATION AND INSTALLATION WITH APPROPRIATE UTILITY
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATION OF ANY PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE STRUCTURES WITH AQUA MAINE AND USE CAUTION IN WORKING IN THOSE AREAS.
- 9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH FAIRPOINT COMMUNICATIONS TO VERIFY THE DEPTH OF CONDUIT UNDER THE PROPOSED GRANITE COBBLE RUMBLE STRIP AND SHALL USE CAUTION IN WORKING IN THAT AREA.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE SPECIAL CARE NOT TO DAMAGE TREES WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO THE CONSTRUCTION AREA.
- 11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RESET OR REBUILD WALKWAYS/STEPS, CURBS, CONCRETE SLABS, STRUCTURES AND FENCES, AND RESTORE PAINT MARKINGS, MULCH, TREES, SHRUBS AND OTHER FEATURES DISTURBED BY HIS OPERATIONS, AS IDENTIFIED ON THE DRAWINGS OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 12. THE OWNER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ANY NECESSARY RIGHTS OF WAY AND EASEMENTS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THAT THE NECESSARY EASEMENTS HAVE BEEN SECURED BY THE OWNER. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO BE FAMILIAR WITH THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF EACH EASEMENT AS COPIES OF ANY SUCH RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS ARE AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW FROM THE TOWN OF
- 13. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE REGULATIONS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA).
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE PRE-CONSTRUCTION PHOTOGRAPHS AND PROVIDE COPIES TO THE OWNER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. THIS WORK SHALL INCLUDE ALL PRIVATE PROPERTY THAT MAY BE IMPACTED BY THE
- 15. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH AND MAINTAIN A TELEPHONE NUMBER WHERE HE CAN BE REACHED 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK, UNTIL THE PROJECT IS SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE.
- 16. LIMIT OF WORK IS AS INDICATED IN THE DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE STAGING OF MATERIALS WITH THE OWNER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
- 17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RIGHT OF PROPERTY IN ANY MATERIALS TAKEN FROM ANY EXCAVATION. SUITABLE EXCAVATED MATERIAL MAY BE INCORPORATED IN THE PROJECT. EXCESS MATERIAL SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY THE CONTRACTOR AT NO COST TO THE OWNER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DISPOSE OF ALL UNSUITABLE AND EXCESS MATERIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND ALL STATE, FEDERAL AND LOCAL REGULATIONS. ALL GRANITE, COBBLE STONES, SIGNAGE, CURBING, SIDEWALK BRICKS AND CATCH BASIN/MANHOLE FRAMES AND COVERS THAT ARE ENCOUNTERED THROUGH THE COURSE OF THE WORK SHALL BE SALVAGED AND TRANSPORTED TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF
- 18. IN THOSE INSTANCES WHERE POWER OR TELEPHONE POLE SUPPORT IS REQUIRED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A MINIMUM 48—HOUR NOTIFICATION TO CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY OR FAIRPOINT, RESPECTIVELY. NO ADDITIONAL PAYMENT WILL BE PROVIDED FOR TEMPORARY BRACING OF UTILITIES.
- 19. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE TO AQUA MAINE AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO PERFORMING WORK.
- 20. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PREVENTION OF EROSION. ALL DISTURBED EARTH SURFACES ARE TO BE STABILIZED IN THE SHORTEST PRACTICAL TIME AND TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE EMPLOYED UNTIL SUCH TIME AS ADEQUATE SOIL STABILIZATION HAS BEEN ACHIEVED. TEMPORARY STORAGE OF EXCAVATED MATERIAL IS TO BE IN A MANNER THAT WILL MINIMIZE EROSION. MATERIALS AND METHODS USED FOR TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE AS SPECIFIED BY THE "MAINE EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL BMP'S." PREPARED BY THE MAINE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.
- 21. ALL STORM DRAINAGE OUTLETS SHALL BE PROTECTED TO PREVENT ENTRY OF SEDIMENT FROM RUNOFF WATERS DURING CONSTRUCTION AND AS DIRECTED BY THE OWNER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ALL COLLECTED SEDIMENT, AND THAT WHICH COLLECTS IN THE STORM DRAIN SYSTEM UNTIL THE PROJECT IS SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE AND READY FOR FINAL PAYMENT.
- 22. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTROL DUST TO A TOLERABLE LIMIT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT TRACK OR SPILL EARTH OR DEBRIS ON PUBLIC STREETS OUTSIDE THE PROJECT AREA. STREETS OPENED TO THE PUBLIC SHALL BE KEPT SWEPT AND FREE OF DEBRIS DAILY.
- 23. ALL BURIED FACILITIES INCLUDING STORMDRAINS, SEWERS AND ELECTRIC HANDHOLES WITH SURFACE ACCESS SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO MATCH FINAL GRADES, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WORK WITH RESPECTIVE UTILITIES FOR ALL OTHER FACILITIES TO BE ADJUSTED.
- 24. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RESET OR REPLACE EXISTING STREET SIGNS DISTURBED BY THE WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE M.U.T.C.D. NEW SIGN POSTS SHALL BE PROVIDED AS NECESSARY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE HIS WORK WITH THE TOWN OF SKOWHEGAN'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.
- 25. COMPACTION TESTS WILL BE REQUIRED. QUALITY CONTROL WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. QUALITY ASSURANCE AND INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OWNER AND THE STATE.
- 26. OPEN TRENCHES IN THE ROADWAY MUST BE BACKFILLED AT THE END OF THE WORKDAY, UNLESS PERMISSION IS GIVEN IN WRITING BY THE OWNER.
- 27. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RESTORE ALL PRIVATE PROPERTY DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION TO ITS PRECONSTRUCTION CONDITION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE PRECAUTIONS IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE DISTURBANCE TO PRIVATE PROPERTY. ALL REPAIRS TO PRIVATE PROPERTY SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.

GENERAL NOTES (CONTINUED)

- 28. ALL AREAS THAT ARE EXCAVATED, FILLED, OR OTHERWISE DISTURBED BY THE CONTRACTOR WHICH ARE NOT TO BE PAVED, SHALL BE LOAMED, GRADED, LIMED, FERTILIZED, SEEDED AND MULCHED, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. THE TOP 4 INCHES OF SOIL SHALL BE LOAM. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL WATER THE SEEDED AREA TO AID IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NEW SEED.
- 29. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR AND REPLACE UTILITIES DAMAGED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OR FOR CONTRACTOR CONVENIENCE AND SHALL PROPERLY DISPOSE OF ANY CORRESPONDING REMOVED MATERIALS.
- 30. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS THAT REMAIN AFTER GRINDING FOR NEW CROSSWALK MARKINGS HAS OCCURED TO ACCOMMODATE NEW PAVEMENT MARKINGS. REMOVAL SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED WITHOUT DAMAGING THE PAVEMENT SURFACE.
- 31. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PRODUCE OR FURNISH PROJECT RECORDS AS REQUIRED BY THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULES, BONDS, SHOP DRAWINGS, WARRANTIES, GUARANTEES. CERTIFICATIONS, AND OTHER SUBMITTALS.
- 32. THE FOLLOWING ITEMS SHALL ALSO BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL: TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION; TEMPORARY PAVING: WEATHER PROTECTION; VISITS TO THE PROJECT SITE OR ELSEWHERE BY PERSONNEL OR AGENTS OF THE CONTRACTOR INCLUDING MANUFACTURER'S REPRESENTATIVES. AS MAY BE REQUIRED: FACILITIES FOR THE STORAGE OF MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE WORK.


WORK ITEMS PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL FALL UNDER PAY ITEMS 652.39 AND 652.38 AND INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:

- . THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING TRAFFIC FLOW AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN TO THE OWNER PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION. THE WATERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT (207-680-4700) AND FIRE DEPARTMENT (207-680-4735) ARE TO BE NOTIFIED AT LEAST 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF ANY STREET CLOSING OR DETOUR.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AS NECESSARY AND IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (M.U.T.C.D.).
