

STATE OF MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “Bids for Crack Sealing in the Towns of Cape Elizabeth, Falmouth, Kennebunk, Lebanon, North Berwick, Old Orchard Beach, Scarborough, South Berwick, Wells, & Windham and Cities of Portland, Saco, Sanford, South Portland, & Westbrook” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (prevailing time) on April 22, 2020 and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size and scope to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening.** Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.

Description: State Project 18995.13, WIN 18995.13 & 24829.00, WIN 24829.00.

Location: In Cumberland and York Counties:

Project 18995.13: Priority 1 is located on US Route 202 from the New Hampshire State Line in Lebanon, north to Ridgeway Street in Sanford. Priority 2 is located on Route 4 beginning in South Berwick from Agamenicus Road, north to the Mary Hurd School in North Berwick. Priority 3 is located on US Route 1 beginning at Route 9 East in Wells, north to Swan Street in Kennebunk. Priority 4 is on Route 115 from Falmouth Road, north to US Route 202 in Windham.

Project 24829.00: Priority 1 is on Ocean House Road in Cape Elizabeth from Ocean House Road North to Ocean House Road South. Priority 2 is on US Route 1 in Falmouth from Andrews Avenue to Reg Roc Road. Priority 3 is on Union Avenue in Old Orchard Beach from Saco Avenue to West Grand Avenue. Priority 4 is on Broadturn Road in Scarborough from Ash Swamp Road to the Interstate 95 overpass. Priority 5 is on Broadway in South Portland from Sawyer Road to Picket Street. Priority 6 is on Foden Road in South Portland from Gorham Road to Western Avenue. Priority 7 is on Eisenhower Drive in Westbrook from Saco Street to Bradley Drive. Priority 8 is on Tuttle Road in Cumberland from the east end of the US Route 1 overpass to Route 88. Priority 9 is on Brook Road in Falmouth from Blackstrap Road to Leighton Road. Priority 10 is on Falmouth Road in Falmouth from Leighton Road to 445 feet south of Winn Street. Priority 11 is on Capisic Street in Portland from Lucas Street to Albion Street. Priority 12 is on Bridge Street in Westbrook from Main Street to North Street. Priority 13 is on Bowery Beach Road in Cape Elizabeth 500 feet west of Beach Rose Lane to Ocean House Road. Priority 14 is on Brook Road in Falmouth from the Westbrook town line to Blackstrap Road. Priority 15 is on Saco Avenue in Old Orchard Beach from Union Street to Adelaide Road. Priority 16 is on Cascade Road South in Saco from the Old Orchard Beach town line to US Route 1. Priority 17 is on Payne Road in Scarborough from the Compact Urban Line (CUL) north of the Beech Ridge to 300 feet north of Bonney Grove Drive. Priority 18 is in Saco on Beach Street from Main Street to Old Orchard Road. Priority 19 is on Westbrook Street in Portland, 1889 feet east of the Westbrook town line to Partridge Road. Priority 20 is on US Route 1 in Cumberland from the Falmouth town line to the Yarmouth town line. Priority 21 is on Fore Street in Portland from Atlantic Street to Mountfort Street. Priority 22 is on Jefferson Street in Biddeford from South Street to Alfred Street. Priority 23 is on Leighton Road in Falmouth from Route 26/100 to Falmouth Road.

Outline of Work: Crack Sealing and other incidental work.

They also may be purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), payment in advance, all non-refundable.

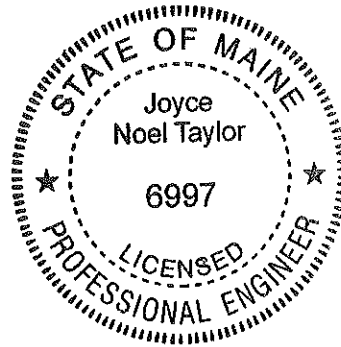
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of \$5,000 payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable State Laws.

All work shall be governed by *State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, November 2014 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and *Standard Details, November 2014 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail].
