Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “Bids for **Crack Sealing in the Towns of Baldwin, Biddeford, Cornish, Gorham, Limerick, Limington, Old Orchard Beach, Scarborough, Standish, and Windham, Cities of Saco and Westbrook**” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **April 21, 2021** and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size and scope to be considered for the award of this contract. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening.** Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.

Description: State Projects 18995.14 & 25669.00.

Location: In Cumberland & York Counties:

Project 18995.14 Priority 1 is located on Route 11 in Limerick and Limington from Prospect Street northeast to Route 117. Priority 2 is located on Route 5 in Limerick and Cornish 0.31 miles South of Town Line north to Route 25. Priority 3 is located on Route 114 in Standish from Route 35 northwest to Joy Lane. Priority 4 is located on Route 113 in Standish and Baldwin from Route 25 to Route 5.

Project 25669.00 Priority 1 is located on Jefferson Street in Biddeford from South Street to Alfred Street. Priority 2 is located on Pine Street in Biddeford from the bridge deck joint to Elm Street. Priority 3 is located on Beach Street in Saco from Main Street to Old Orchard Road. Priority 4 is located on Spring Street in Saco from North Street to Lincoln Street. Priority 5 is located on Garfield Street in Saco from North Street to Cherryfield Avenue. Priority 6 is located on Falmouth Road in Windham from the Falmouth town line to Albion Road. Priority 7 is located on New Portland Road in Gorham from Lowell Road to the Westbrook city line. Priority 8 is located on Libby Avenue in Gorham from New Portland Road to Main Street. Priority 9 is located on Payne Road in Scarborough 0.14 miles north of Milliken Road to Beech Ridge Road. Priority 10 is located on Payne Road in Scarborough 2000’ north of Beech Ridge Road to 300’ north of Bonney Grove Drive. Priority 11 is located on Payne Road in Scarborough from Ginn Road to Mussey Road. Priority 12 is located on Spurwink Road in Scarborough from Acorn Lane to Blackpoint Road. Priority 14 is located on Broadturn Road in Scarborough 100’ west of Diner Drive to Martin Avenue. Priority 14 is located on Broadturn Road in Scarborough from Martin Avenue to Carpenter Court. Priority 15 is located on Main Street in Biddeford from 660’ west of Mount Pleasant Street to South Street. Priority 16 is located on Forest Street in Westbrook from Rochester Street to Main Street. Priority 17 is located on Stroudwater Street in Westbrook from Forest Street to 1550’ south of Laffin Drive. Priority 18 is located on East Bridge Street in Old Orchard Beach from Old Orchard Street to Walnut Street.
