

STATE OF MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “Bids for Crack Sealing in the Towns of Casco, Durham, Freeport, Naples, New Gloucester, Old Orchard Beach, Raymond, Scarborough, Windham, and Cities of Biddeford and Saco” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on May 3, 2023 and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size and scope to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.**

Location: Project 18995.56:

In Androscoggin and Cumberland Counties:

Priority 1 is located on Route 26 beginning from Gray/New Gloucester Town Line to 0.22 miles South of Route 122.

In Cumberland County:

Priority 2 is located on US Route 302 in Windham; Section 1: Beginning 0.08 miles south of Pope Road and extending north to Johnson Road. Section2: Beginning 0.2 miles north of Albion Road extending north to US Route 202.

Priority 3 is located on US Route 302 beginning 38 miles North of Enterprise Drive in Windham extending North to 0.11 miles south of Harrison Road in Naples.

In Androscoggin County:

Priority 4 is located on Route 125 in Freeport beginning 0.73 miles North of Route 136 extending North to 0.16 miles south of Lunt Road.

Priority 5 is located on Route 136 beginning at the Freeport/Durham Town Line extending North to Durham/Auburn Town/City Line.

In York County:

Priority 1 is located in Old Orchard Beach on East Grand Avenue from Old Orchard Street to Walnut Street.

Priority 2 is located in Saco on Cascade Road from the Old Orchard Beach Town Line to Portland Road.

Priority 3 is located in Saco on Seaside Avenue from Ferry Road to the Old Orchard Beach Town Line.

Priority 4 is located in Scarborough on Pine Point Road from Dunstan Landing Road to US Route 1.

Priority 5 is located in Scarborough on Payne Road from Beech Ridge Road to 2000’ North of Beech Ridge Road.

Priority 6 is located in Scarborough on Pleasant Hill Road from Fogg Road to Spurwink Road.

Priority 7 is located in Biddeford on Main Street from 660’ West of Mount Pleasant Street to South Street.

Priority 8 is located in Biddeford on Alfred Street from 186’ East of US Route 1 to Route 1.

In Cumberland County:

Priority 9 is located in Biddeford on South Street from Mount Pleasant Street to Village Lane.

Priority 10 is located in Windham on the Tandberg Trail from the Standish Town Line to Roosevelt Trail.

Priority 11 is located in Windham on Windham Center Road from River Road to Gray Road.

Priority 12 is located in Windham on the Falmouth Road from the Tandberg Trail to Varney Mill Road.

In York County:

Priority 13 is located in Saco on Bradley Street from Spring Street to Tasker Street.
