

STATE OF MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “Bids for Rumble Strip Installation in the Towns of Alfred, Arundel, Aurora, Blaine, Bridgewater, Brunswick, Cherryfield, Eddington, Edgcomb, Frankfort, Gouldsboro, Harrington, Houlton, Jonesboro, Littleton, Monticello, Newcastle, Pembroke, Prospect, Robbinston, Rockport, Topsham, Van Buren, and Waldoboro, Plantation of Baring, and Cities of Calais, Caribou, and Presque Isle” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on June 30, 2021 and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a Highway Construction, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.**

Description: Maine Federal Aid Project No. HSIP-2423(500), WIN 24235.00.

Location: In Lincoln County:

Segment 1: On US Route 1, beginning at the end of painted island east of Old Route One (RLM 96.33) in Edgcomb and continuing 2.58 miles to connect to the existing rumble strips north of Lynch Road (RLM 98.91) in Newcastle.

Segment 2: On US Route 1 in Waldoboro, beginning at the end of painted island north of Route 220/Route 1 (RLM 112.51) and continuing 2.91 miles to the existing centerline rumble strips just north of Old Route 1 (RLM 115.42).

In Knox County:

Segment 3: On US Route 1 in Rockport, beginning at the pavement joint north Of Sea Light Lane (RLM 132.26) and continuing 0.66 miles to the 35 mph sign south of Pandion Lane (RLM 132.92).

In Hancock County:

Segment 4: On US Route 1 in Gouldsboro, beginning at the existing rumble strips west of Cross Road (RLM 208.50) and continuing 5.53 miles to the 50 mph sign north of Guzzle Road (RLM 214.03).

In Washington County:

Segment 5: On US Route 1, beginning in Cherryfield at the 45 mph sign west of the Cherryfield/Milbridge town line (RLM 229.22) and continuing 5.44 miles to the 30 mph sign east of Sharon Lane (RLM 234.26). Beginning at the 55 mph sign north of the Route 1/1A intersection (RLM 235.65) in Harrington continuing 11.29 miles to the east side of Route 187 intersection (RLM 246.94) in Jonesboro.

Segment 6: On US Route 1 in Pembroke, beginning at the 50mph sign north of Route 214 intersection (RLM 287.04) and continuing 13.52 miles to the 35 mph sign north of Robins Road (RLM 300.56).

On US Route 1, beginning at the 55 mph sign south of Maple Lane (RLM 302.13) in Robbinston and continuing 10.02 miles to the 40 mph sign south of Steamboat Street (RLM 312.33) in Calais.

On US Route 1, beginning at the end of the second island south of the rotary (RLM 316.38) in Calais and continuing 4.05 miles to the 40 mph sign south of Park Road (RLM 320.43) in Baring Plantation.

In Aroostook County:

Segment 7: On US Route 1 in Houlton, beginning at the 55 mph sign north of Currier Road (RLM 407.48) and continuing 9.35 miles to the 30 mph sign north of Station Road (RLM 416.83).

On US Route 1, beginning at the 45 mph sign north of Fletcher Road (RLM 418.05) in Monticello and continuing 6.44 miles to the 40 mph sign north of Snow Road (RLM 424.49) in Bridgewater.

On US Route 1, beginning at the 55 mph sign north of Packard Road (RLM 426.08) in Bridgewater and continuing 4.90 miles to the 35 mph sign south of East Plantation Road (RLM 430.98) in Blaine.

Segment 8: On US Route 1, beginning at the 45 mph sign north of Route 164 WASHINGTON Road intersection (RLM 448.32) in Presque Isle and continuing 10.07 miles to the 35 mph sign south of Patten Street(RLM 458.39) in Caribou.

On US Route 1, beginning at the 45 mph sign south of Main Street (RLM 460.22) in Caribou and continuing 4.49 miles to the 40 mph sign south of Albion Road (RLM 430.98) in Van Buren.

On US Route 1 in Van Buren, beginning at the 50 mph sign south of Townline Road (RLM 465.45) and continuing 14.92 miles to the 35 mph sign south of Tower Road (RLM 480.37).

In Waldo County:

Segment 9: On US Route 1A beginning at the pavement joint near the Prospect/Frankfort town line (RLM 20.47) in Prospect and continuing 1.82 miles to the 40 mph sign south of OLD BELFAST ROAD (RLM 22.29) in Frankfort.

On US Route 1A in Frankfort, beginning at the 50 mph sign north of Hall Road (RLM 23.04) and continuing 1.54 miles to the 35 mph sign north of Apple Hill Lane (RLM 24.58).

In Penobscot and Hancock Counties:

Segment 10: On Route 9, beginning at the 50 mph sign east of Bangor Water Works Road (RLM 205.38) in Eddington and continuing 15.91 miles to the island west of Old Airline Road (RLM 221.29) in Aurora.

In York County:

Segment 11: On Route 111, beginning at the 50 mph sign west of New Road (RLM 4.36) in Arundel and continuing 9.13 miles to the intersection of Route 111/Kennebunk Road (RLM 13.49) in Alfred.

In Androscoggin and Sagadahoc Counties:

Segment 12: On Route 196, beginning at the end of the north ramp island (RLM 0.26) in Brunswick and continuing 0.15 miles to the island at the intersection of Elm Street/Middlesex Road (RLM 0.41) in Topsham.

On Route 196, beginning at the island north of Bypass Drive (RLM 0.69) in Topsham and continuing 0.47 miles to the island east of Community Way/Village Drive (RLM 1.16)

Outline of Work: Rumble Strip Installation and other incidental work.

They also may be purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), payment in advance, all non-refundable.


Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of 5% of the bid amount, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable Federal Laws. This contract is subject to compliance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program requirements as set forth by the Maine Department of Transportation.

All work shall be governed by *State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and *Standard Details, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail].
