NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “**Light Capital Paving** in the towns of **Alexander, Baileyville, Cooper, Dennysville, Perry, Princeton, and Robbinston**, the township of **Edmunds**, the reservation of **Passamaquoddy Pleasant Point**, and the city of **Calais**” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, Maine DOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **March 24th, 2021** and at that time and place publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a Highway Construction or Paving Prequalification, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for those bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: the Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening.** Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.

Description: WIN 24493.00

Location: In Washington County, project is located:

Map ID 1 is in Calais on South Street beginning at the southerly intersection with Route 1 and extending northeasterly to the northerly intersection with Route 1. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 2 is in Cooper and Alexander on the North Union Road and the Cooper Road beginning on the North Union Road at the intersection with Route 191 and extending northerly to the Cooper Road; then continuing northerly on the Cooper Road to the intersection with Route 9. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 3 is in Calais on North Street beginning at the intersection with Route 1/9 and extending northwesterly to the United States Customs facility. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 4 is in Baileyville on the Access Road beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending northeasterly to the intersection with Main Street. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 5 is in Calais on International Avenue beginning at the intersection with Route 1/9 and extending westerly 0.16 miles to the United States Customs facility. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 6 & 9 is in Calais on Route 1/9 beginning at the intersection with Boardman Street and extending southerly to the intersection with the Magurrewock Road. Includes paving shoulders and paving the roundabout and all legs.

Map ID 7 is in Perry and Pleasant Point on Route 190 beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending southeasterly to the Pleasant Point/Eastport line. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 8 is in Princeton and Alexander on the South Princeton Road beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending southerly to the intersection with Route 9.

Map ID 10 is in Robbinston and Calais on Route 1 beginning 0.07 miles northwest of the intersection with the Brewer Road and extending northwesterly to 0.08 miles northwest of the intersection with the Shattuck Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 11 is in Perry on Route 1 beginning 0.06 miles east of the intersection with the Cannon Hill Road and extending northeasterly to 0.17 north of the intersection with the Shore Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 12 is in Edmunds Twp. and Dennysville on Route 1 beginning 1.97 miles north of the Whiting/Edmunds line and extending northerly to 0.11 miles north of the intersection with the Shipyard Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Outline of Work: Light Capital Paving and other incidental work.

Total length is 35.80 miles

They may be purchased from the Department between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. by cash, credit card (Visa/Mastercard) or check payable to Treasurer, State of Maine sent to Maine Department of Transportation, Attn.: Mailroom, 16 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0016. They also may be purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), Single Sheets \$2, payment in advance, all non-refundable.

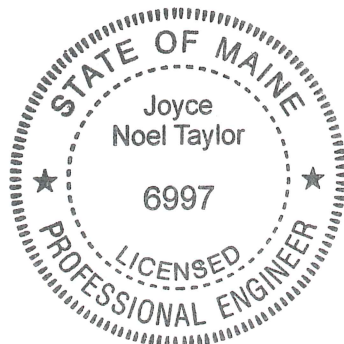
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of \$40,000 payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable State Laws.

All work shall be governed by "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition", price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and Standard Details, March 2020 Edition, price \$20 [\$25 by mail].
