NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “**Light Capital Paving** in the towns of **Buckfield, Canton, Dixfield, Fayette, Hartford, Jay, Livermore, Livermore Falls, Sumner, and Turner**” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, Maine DOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021** and at that time and place publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a Highway Construction or Paving Prequalification, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for those bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: the Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.**

Location: In Androscoggin, Franklin, Kennebec, and Oxford Counties, project is located:

Map ID 1 is in Fayette on Route 17 beginning at the Readfield/Fayette townline and extending northwesterly to 0.16 miles south of the intersection with the Baldwin Hill Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 2 is in Sumner, Hartford, and Buckfield on Route 140 beginning at the westerly junction of Route 219 and extending southerly to the intersection with Route 117. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 3 is in Turner on the Weston Road beginning at the intersection with Route 4 and extending southwestly to the intersection with Route 117. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 4 is in Jay on Route 140 beginning at the intersection with Route 4/17 and extending northeasterly to the Seven Mile Stream Bridge #3801. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 5 is in Turner on Route 117 beginning at the intersection with the Cobb Road and extending northerly to the intersection with Route 219.

Map ID 6 is in Livermore and Jay on the Crash Road beginning at the intersection with Route 4 and extending northerly to the intersection with the Riley Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 7 is in Turner on Route 219 beginning 0.02 miles south of the intersection with Route 4 and extending southeasterly to 0.04 miles east of the intersection with Route 117. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 8 is in Dixfield and Canton on the Canton Point Road beginning at the intersection with Route 2/17 and extending southeasterly to the intersection with Route 140. Includes paving shoulders and milling and paving Bridge #3243.

Map ID 9 & 13 is in Turner on the Center Bridge Road beginning at the Turner Center Bridge #3426 and extending northwesterly to the intersection with Route 117. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 10 is in Canton on Route 140 beginning 0.76 miles south of the intersection with the Canton Point Road and extending southerly to the intersection with Route 108. Includes paving shoulders and milling and paving Bridge #6244.

Map ID 11 is in Turner and Livermore on Route 108 beginning at the intersection with Route 219 and extending northeasterly to the easterly junction of Route 4. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 12 is in Livermore Falls on Route 106 beginning at the Leeds/Livermore Falls townline and extending northerly to the intersection with Route 133. Includes paving shoulders.

Map ID 14 is in Livermore on Route 108 beginning at the westerly junction of Route 4 and extending northwesterly to the intersection with the Canton Road. Includes paving shoulders.

Outline of Work: Light Capital Paving and other incidental work.

Total length is 41.79 miles

They also may be purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), Single Sheets \$2, payment in advance, all non-refundable.

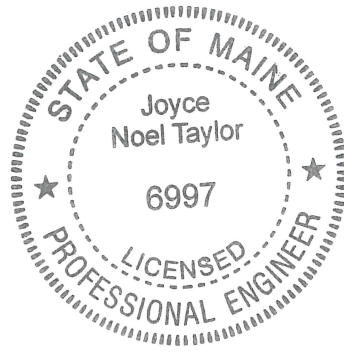
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of \$40,000 payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable State Laws.

All work shall be governed by "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition", price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and Standard Details, March 2020 Edition, price \$20 [\$25 by mail].
