Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper "Bids for **Rumble Strip Installation** in the towns of **Acton, Alfred, Brownfield, Canton, Dover-Foxcroft, Eliot, Gorham, Farmington, Fryeburg, Glenburn, Hiram, Kenduskeag, Kennebunk, Livermore, New Sharon, Northport, Peru, Sanford, South Berwick, Troy, Unity, Waterboro, Wells, Wilton, Windham, Woodstock**, and the city of **Bangor**" will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **June 28, 2023** and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a **Highway Construction prequalification**, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening.** Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.

Description: Maine Federal Aid Project No. 2498700 WIN. 024987.00

Location: In Oxford County

Segment 1: On Route 5 in Hiram, beginning at the 45-mph sign between the two intersections for Shotgun Gulch and continuing north for 12.5 miles to the 35-mph sign near Porter Road in Fryeburg.

In York County

Segment 2: On Route 109 in Wells, beginning in between the intersections of El Velvel Circle and continuing north for 2.31 miles to Kennebunk Road in Sanford.

Segment 3: On Route 109 in Acton, beginning at the 50-mph sign north of 7th Street and continuing 3.63 miles.

Segment 4: On Route 202 in Alfred, beginning at the 50-mph sign just east of Central Maine Power building and continuing east for 1.64 miles.

Segment 5: On Route 202 in Alfred, beginning at the 45-mph sign north of Kennebunk Road continuing north for 2.93 miles to the 35-mph sign near Downeast Auto in Waterboro.

Segment 6: On Route 202 in Waterboro, beginning at the 55-mph sign at the intersection of Straw Mill Brook Road continuing east 2.23 miles.

In Cumberland County

Segment 7: On Route 202 in Gorham, beginning at the 45-mph sign north of Wentworth Drive and continuing northeast for 2.05 miles.

In York County

Segment 8: On Route 236 in Eliot, beginning just north of Depot Road and continuing north for 5.52 miles to the 35-mph sign near Marshwood Great Works School.

In Cumberland County

Segment 9: On Route 302 in Windham, beginning just before the 45-mph sign north of Hall Road continuing north for 0.46 miles.

In Waldo County

Segment 10: On Route 1 in Northport, beginning just north of Corner Stone Kitchens and continuing north for 2.7 miles.

Segment 11: On Route 202 in Unity, beginning at the 45-mph sign near the Railroad tracks and continuing east for 8.59 miles to the Troy/Dixmont town line.

In Franklin County

Segment 12: On Route 2 in Wilton, beginning at the 50-mph sign just north of Munson Road and continuing east for 3.06 miles to just after the Wilton/Farmington town line.

Segment 13: On Route 202 in Farmington, beginning just south of the Farmington Motel and continuing east 6.49 miles to the 40-mph sign near Greg's Auto Repair in New Sharon.

In Androscoggin County

SEGMENT 14: On Route 4 in Livermore, beginning at the 50-mph sign just north of Hathaway Hill Road and continuing north for 2.55 miles.

In Oxford County

Segment 15: On Route 26 in Woodstock, beginning at the West Paris/Woodstock town line and continuing west 4.56 miles.

Segment 16: On Route 108 in Peru, beginning at the 55-mph sign west of the River Road and continuing west 5.53 miles.

In Androscoggin/Oxford Counties

Segment 17: On Route 108 in Livermore, beginning at the 55-mph sign east of Church Street and continuing east for 4.74 miles to the 35-mph sign past the Canton Town Office in Canton.

In Oxford County

Segment 18: On Route 108 in Canton, beginning at the 55-mph sign north of Edmunds Road and continuing north for 1.21 miles.

In Penobscot County

Segment 19: On Route 15 in Bangor, beginning at the Six Mile Falls Bridge and continuing north 6.10 miles to the 35-mph sign just past Trafton Lane in Kenduskeag.

Segment 20: On Route 15 in Dover-Foxcroft, beginning at the 45-mph sign before South Dover Cemetery and continuing north for 4.54 miles.

Outline of Work: Rumble Strip Installation and other incidental work.

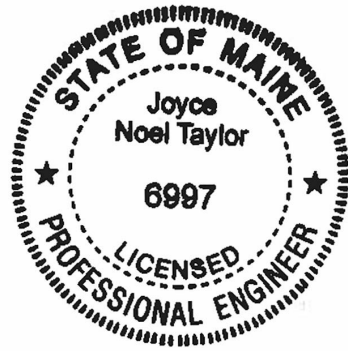
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of 5% of the bid amount, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable Federal Laws. This contract is subject to compliance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program requirements as set forth by the Maine Department of Transportation.

All work shall be governed by *State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and *Standard Details, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail].
