NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “**Light Capital Paving and PMRAP Laydown** in the towns of **Addison, Beals, Columbia Falls, East Machias, Harrington, Jonesboro, Jonesport, Machias, Machiasport, Marshfield, Northfield, Roque Bluffs, Wesley, and Whitneyville** will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, Maine DOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **March 6, 2024** and at that time and place publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a Highway Construction or Paving Prequalification, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for those bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: the Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.**

Description: WINs 026786.00 & 028518.00

Location: In Washington County, project is located:

Map IDs 1 & 2 are in Jonesboro, Whitneyville, Marshfield, and Machias on Route 1A beginning at the intersection with Route 1 in Jonesboro and extending northeasterly to the intersection with Route 1 in Machias.

Map ID 3 is in Machias and Machiasport on Route 92 beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending southerly to 0.05 miles east of the intersection with Old County Road.

Map ID 4 is in Columbia Falls, Addison, Jonesport, and Jonesboro on Route 187 beginning at the westerly intersection with Route 1 and extending southerly then northerly to the easterly intersection with Route 1.

Map IDs 5 & 6 are in Machias, Marshfield, Whitneyville, Northfield, and Wesley on Route 192 beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending northerly to the intersection with Route 9. To include PMRAP spot shimming.

Map ID 7 is in East Machias and Machiasport on the Rim Road beginning at the intersection with Route 1 and extending southerly to the intersection with Route 92.

Map ID 8 is in Marshfield and Machias on the Ridge Road beginning at the intersection with Route 192 and extending easterly to the intersection with the Hadley Lake Road; then continuing southerly on the Hadley Lake Road to the intersection with Route 1.

Map ID 9 is in Roque Bluffs, Whitneyville and Machias on the Roque Bluffs Road beginning 0.57 miles south of Johnson Cove Road extending northerly to the intersection with Route 1.

Map ID 10 is in Jonesboro and Roque Bluffs on Great Cove Road beginning at intersection with Route 1 and extending southeasterly to the intersection with the Roque Bluffs Road.

Map ID 11 is in Addison on Basin Road, East Side Road, and Wescogus Road beginning on Basin Road at the intersection with Route 187 and continuing southwesterly to the intersection with the Mooseneck Road; then continuing northerly on East Side Road to the intersection with Water Street; then continuing easterly on Wescogus Road to the intersection with Route 187.

Map ID 12 is in Beals on Bayview Drive beginning at the intersection with Bridge Street and extending southerly to the intersection with Black Duck Cove Road.

Map ID 13 is in Harrington on the Dorman Road beginning at the intersection with Route 1A and extending northerly to the intersection with Route 1.

Map ID 14 is in Beals and Jonesport on Bridge Street beginning at the intersection with Bayview Drive and extending northerly to the intersection with Route 187.

Map ID 15 is in Machiasport on the Port Road beginning 0.04 miles northeasterly of the intersection of Base Road and extending northerly to the beginning of Route 92 by Old County Road (abuts Map ID 3).

Outline of Work: Light Capital Paving and other incidental work.

Total length is 94.54 miles.

They may be purchased from the Department between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. by cash, credit card (Visa/Mastercard) or check payable to Treasurer, State of Maine sent to Maine Department of Transportation, Attn.: Mailroom, 16 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0016. They also may be purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), Single Sheets \$2, payment in advance, all non-refundable.

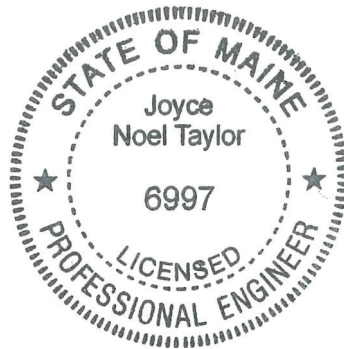
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of 5% of the bid amount, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable State Laws.

All work shall be governed by "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition", price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and Standard Details, March 2020 Edition, price \$20 [\$25 by mail].
