Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper “**Light Capital Paving** in the towns of **Herman, Corinna, Newport, Stetson, Pittsfield, Dixmont, Hampden, Newburgh, Bradford, Milo, Exeter, Corinth, Kenduskeag, Levant, Troy, Garland, Etna, Orrington, Detroit, Palmyra**, the city of **Brewer**, and the township of **Orneville**” will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, Maine DOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o’clock A.M. (prevailing time) on **March 12, 2025** and at that time and place publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or successfully complete, a **Highway Construction, Paving**, or project specific prequalification to be considered for the award of this contract. **We now accept electronic bids for those bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: the Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.**

Location: In Penobscot & Piscataquis Counties, project is located:

Map #1 is in Herman on Odlin Road beginning at the Bangor town line and extending west 1.32 miles to Coldbrook Road. Includes paved shoulders (50 tons)

Map #2 is in Corinna, Newport & Stetson on Route 222 beginning at Route 43 and extending south 7.18 miles to Route 143. Bridge Milling #2788.

Map #3 is in Pittsfield on Route 11 beginning at the Burnham town line and extending north 5.74 miles. Includes paved shoulders (100 tons) Bridge Milling #2634 & #2784.

Map #4 is in Dixmont, Hampden & Newburgh on Kennebec Road beginning at Route 9 and extending east 15.24 miles to the North Main Road. Includes paved shoulders (200 tons).

Map #5 is in Bradford, Milo & Orneville Township on Route 11 beginning at Route 155 and extending north 12.28 miles to Elm Street. Bridge Milling #5121.

They also may be

purchased by telephone at (207) 624-3536 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Bid Book \$10 (\$13 by mail), Single Sheets \$2, payment in advance, all non-refundable.


Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of 5% of the bid amount, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable State Laws.

All work shall be governed by "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition", price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and Standard Details, March 2020 Edition, price \$20 [\$25 by mail].
