Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper "Bids for Rumble Strip Installation in the towns of Avon, Belgrade, Bridgton, Canaan, Eagle Lake, Farmington, Fort Fairfield, Littleton, Madawaska, Mars Hill, Monticello, New Gloucester, New Sharon, New Sweden, Phillips, Rockport, Skowhegan, Strong, Wallagrass, & the cities of Ellsworth & Presque Isle, will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, MaineDOT Building, Capitol Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (prevailing time) on July 1, 2026, and at that time and place, publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size or scope to be considered for the award of this project. We now accept electronic bids for bid packages posted on the bidx.com website. Electronic bids do not have to be accompanied by paper bids. Please note: The Department will accept a facsimile of the bid bond; however, the original bid bond must then be received at the MDOT Contract Section within 72 hours of the bid opening. Until further notice, dual bids (one paper, one electronic) will be accepted, with the paper copy taking precedence.

In Region 1:

In Cumberland County:

On Route 302 in Bridgton 0.17 miles north of the intersection of 302/93 and extending north 3.96 miles.

On Route 202 in New Gloucester beginning at the Gray/New Gloucester extending east 6.4 miles. Skip 0.94 miles due to low-Speed limit.

In Region 2:

In Knox County:

On Route 1 in Rockport beginning 50 feet northwest of Old County Road extending west 1.51 miles to Sea Light Lane.

In Kennebec County:

On Route 27 in Belgrade/New Sharon beginning 1.41 miles north of Belgrade TL Extending 17.72 miles to Route 2. Skip 2 areas of 1.07 miles and 1.02 miles due to speed limit below 45 mph.

In Region 3:

In Somerset County:

On Route 2 in Skowhegan/Canaan beginning at 50 mph sign 500 feet east of intersection of Water Malbon Streets and extending 6.97 miles east to a 35-mph sign.

In Franklin County:

On Route 4 in Strong/Avon/Phillips beginning 0.38 miles north of the Intersection of Route 145 and extending north 16.32 miles.

On Route 4 in Farmington/Strong beginning 0.07 miles South of Route 27 and extending north 8.27 miles.

In Region 4:

In Hancock County:

On Route 1 in Ellsworth beginning 0.12 miles northwest of Beechwood Lane and extending northwest 14.12 miles to a 35-mph sign.

In Region 5:

In Aroostook County:

On Route 161 in New Sweden/Madawaska Lake Township beginning 0.24 miles north of Station Road extending north 9.1 miles.

On Route 1 in Presque Isle beginning 0.06 miles north of Westfield/Presque Isle TL and extending north 5.2 miles.

On Route 1 in Littleton/Monticello beginning 0.36 miles north of Wiley and Little Road and extending north 10.2 miles. Skip 1.22 miles due to speed limit below 45 mph.

On Route 1A in Fort Fairfield beginning 0.35 miles north of Route 161 at a 45-mph sign extending north 6.07 miles.

On Route 1A in Fort Fairfield beginning 0.16 miles north of Upcountry Road extending north 4.76 miles to a 25-mph sign.

On Route 1A in Mars Hill beginning 0.08 miles north of East Ridge Road at the 55-mph sign extending north 1.74 miles.

On Route 11 in Wallagrass/Eagle Lake beginning at a 50-mph sign in front of the picnic area in Eagle Lake
And extending north to a 35-mph sign.

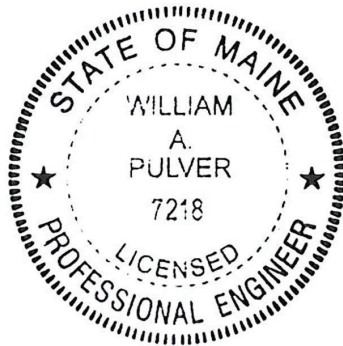
Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Department and must be accompanied by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier's check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of 5% of the bid amount, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine as a Bid guarantee. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable Federal Laws. This contract is subject to compliance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program requirements as set forth by the Maine Department of Transportation.

All work shall be governed by *State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail], and *Standard Details, March 2020 Edition*, price \$10 [\$15 by mail].
