Sealed Bids for the West Commercial Street Multi-use Path & Sidewalk Improvements Project in the City of Portland shall be submitted electronically to bidssubmit@portlandmaine.gov with the name of the Bidder, Contract Name and Bid number in the subject line will be **received until 3:30 p.m., Wednesday, December 21, 2022**, at which time they will be opened and read. Proposals may also be submitted via USPS, UPS, FedEx, or in person to the City of Portland, Purchasing Rm. 103, 389 Congress St., Portland ME 04101. It is the bidder's sole responsibility to ensure that their bid is submitted prior to the date and time specified. Late or unsigned bids shall not be accepted.

Description: West Commercial Street Multi-Use Path & Sidewalk Improvements, Bid #23035

Location: In Cumberland County, project is located on the north side of West Commercial Street beginning at the Emery Street intersection and extending approximately 0.13 miles to the east in Portland.

Outline of Work: This project includes construction of a paved multi-use pathway and a brick sidewalk with new curbing, drainage improvements, curb extensions and signing and striping improvements as well as other incidental work.

Construction under this contract will be funded by Federal Grants under the Federal Highway Administration and will be subject to all applicable requirements of the U.S Department of Transportation. It will be administered locally by the City of Portland in conjunction with the Maine Department of Transportation and will also be subject to all of their applicable documents.
