Bids are requested for the

**STATE STREET & HOGAN ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT**

**MeDOT PROJECT NUMBER STP-2352(100)X/ STP-2413(100)X**

The project includes the milling and placing new hot mix asphalt surface on a portion of State Street and Hoagan Road in Bangor, Maine, and will include some curb replacement, sidewalk pavement overlay, along with other incidental work.

The State Street Resurfacing Project is a Maine Federal Aid Project No. STP 2352(100)X, MeDOT WIN 23521.00, located along a portion of State Street starting at Hancock Street and extending easterly 0.95 miles to Hogan Road, Bangor, Maine.

The Hogan Road Resurfacing Project is a Maine Federal Aid Project No. STP 2413(100)X, MeDOT WIN 24131.00, located along a portion of Hogan Road starting at State Street and extending northerly 0.62 miles to Mount Hope Avenue, Bangor, Maine.

A **prebid meeting** will be held on June 7 at 2:00 p.m. at the City of Bangor's Engineering Department, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine. Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price will be required in the form of cash, a certified check or bid bond.

This project is subject to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wage Rate Determination. All work shall be governed by State of Maine Department of Transportation, "Standard Specification", revision of March 2020, and "Standard Details", revision of March 2020.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids or to waive informalities or defects in bids if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. Basis of award of Contract is determined by the lowest qualified bidder. **The lowest bidder must have successfully completed a Highway, or project specific prequalification for Bangor to consider the award of this contract.**
