Bids are requested for the

Mount Hope Avenue Sidewalk Project
MeDOT WIN 028458.00

The project includes constructing a new 6' wide sidewalk along Mount Hope Avenue in Bangor, Maine, and will include 15 new catch basins, 4 drain manholes, 1,663 linear feet of storm drain, concrete curb placement, and other incidental work. The Project is located along a portion of Mount Hope Avenue starting near Saratoga Avenue and extending easterly 0.45 miles towards Hogan Road, Bangor, Maine.

For consideration, the attached bid form sealed in an envelope, distinctly marked: **"PROPOSAL P27-29: MOUNT HOPE AVENUE SIDEWALK PROJECT"** must be received at the Office of the City of Bangor Purchasing Agent by **2:00 PM, Wednesday, October 14, 2026.** Submissions of the documents can be completed by:

A non-mandatory informational pre-bid meeting will be held in the Paul Bunyan Room at Bangor City Hall, 73 Harlow Street Bangor, ME on September 30, 2026 at 9 AM.

Proposals will be publicly opened at the time stated above at the Bangor City Hall, in the Paul Bunyan Room, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor Maine. A tabulation of all received proposals will be posted on the City's website as soon as possible after the opening date. Visit www.bangormaine.gov/bids for results. The "Show Closed/Awarded/Cancelled Bids" box must be checked to see the proposal information.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price will be required in the form of cash, a certified check or bid bond. All work shall be governed by State of Maine Department of Transportation, "Standard Specification," revision of March 2026, and "Standard Details," revision of March 2026. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids or to waive informalities or defects in bids if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. Basis of award of the Contract is determined by the lowest qualified bidder. **The lowest bidder must have successfully completed a Highway or project-specific prequalification for Bangor to be considered for the award of this contract.**

An addendum will be posted to the City website on **Friday, October 9, 2026**.
