BROADWAY / STILLWATER AVE SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The project includes the replacement of existing traffic signals with new traffic signals at the Broadway / Stillwater Avenue Intersection, along with other incidental work.

The Broadway / Stillwater Ave Signal Improvements Project is a MaineDOT Federal Aid Project No. 2847600, MaineDOT WIN 028476.00, located at the intersection of Broadway and Stillwater Avenue, Bangor, Maine.

For consideration, the attached bid form sealed in an envelope, distinctly marked "**PROPOSAL #P27-01 BROADWAY / STILLWATER AVE SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT,**" must be received at the Office of the City of Bangor Purchasing Agent by **2:00 PM, Wednesday, August 5, 2026.** Email submissions will not be accepted. A **prebid meeting** will be held on **Tuesday, July 28, 2026** at 1:30 p.m. at the Bangor City Hall 1st Floor Penobscot Conference Room, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine. Proposals will be publicly opened at the time stated above at the Bangor City Hall, in the Paul Bunyan Room, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor Maine. A tabulation of all received proposals will be posted on the City's website by 4:30 PM on the opening date. Visit www.bangormaine.gov/bids for results. The "Show Closed/Awarded/Cancelled Bids" box must be checked to see the proposal information.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price will be required in the form of cash, a certified check or bid bond. All work shall be governed by State of Maine Department of Transportation, "Standard Specifications," revision of March 2020, and "Standard Details," revision of March 2020. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids or to waive informalities or defects in bids if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. Basis of award of the Contract is determined by the lowest qualified bidder. **The lowest bidder must have successfully completed a Highway or project-specific prequalification for Bangor to be considered for the award of this contract.**
