Description

The Contractor shall furnish, fabricate and deliver all bridge expansion joint armor and associated hardware shown on the following plan set:

- South Portland, Bridge #1513 – I 295 SB over Rt 703

The steel expansion joint armor and hardware shall meet the requirements of this Contract, the Plans, the State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications & Standard Details, March 2020 Edition including, but not limited to Section 520 Expansion Devices – Non-Modular as updated through advertisement, Supplemental Specification and Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall provide the Department with notice per Standard Specification Section 504. (Call or email Joe Stilwell @ 207-215-3643 or Fabrication.MaineDOT@maine.gov.)

Delivery

Delivery of finished products shall be within the timeframe stated in Section B. Time of the Contract. If construction of the subject project is delayed and the expansion joint is not able to be delivered and installed, the Manufacturer shall store the expansion joint for the delayed project until a date not later than September 30, 2021.

The Manufacturer shall deliver the expansion joint to the project site on a weekday (Monday to Friday) in coordination with the onsite Contractors who are installing the expansion joint. The expansion joint shall be delivered to the project site by the manufacturer:

Project: WIN 23615.04 South Portland I 295 SB 703 and Westbrook Bridges

Location: Project Site, located 0.6 miles north of the Portland South Toll Plaza

MaineDOT in conjunction with the Department's Contractors installing the expansion joint must give the Manufacturer a minimum of 7 calendar days' notice of when the expansion joint shall be delivered. The Contractors who are installing the expansion joint shall be responsible for unloading the expansion joint at or near the project site in a timely fashion. Any incidental materials needed to temporarily store the expansion joint at the project site shall be provided by the Contractor responsible for installation. The Manufacturer will supply MaineDOT Project Manager, Mackenzie Kersbergen, (207) 215-3820, with the appropriate project submittals. Alternative contact is: Joe Stilwell, Fabrication Engineer, (207) 215-3643. MaineDOT shall provide the Manufacturer with the contact information for the Contractor responsible for installation of the expansion joint upon award of the installation Contract.

Buy America

The products which are manufactured of steel or iron shall have been manufactured in the United States. Ore, for the manufacture of steel or iron, may be from outside the United States; however, all other manufacturing processes of steel or iron must be in the United States to

qualify as having been manufactured in the United States. United States includes the 50 United States and any place subject to the jurisdiction thereof.

To assure compliance with this section, the Contractor shall submit a certification letter on its letterhead to the Department stating the following:

“This is to certify that products made of steel, iron or the application of any coating to products of these materials whose costs are in excess of \$2,500.00 or 0.1 percent of the original contract amount, whichever is greater, were manufactured and the coating, if one was required, was applied in the United States.”

Invoices and Payments

The Contractor shall submit an itemized bill to the Department for materials following delivery for approval and payment. At a minimum, invoices shall include the following information:

Contractor name, address & Contract Number
Invoice Date & Number
Project Town & WIN
Work item/description
Dates of Delivery

The Department will pay based upon the materials delivered at the prices bid and the invoices approved. Payments to the Contractor shall be full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, services, and incidentals used to supply the materials under the Contract in a complete and acceptable manner, and for all risk, loss, damage, or expense of any kind arising from the nature or prosecution of the Work. The Department may withhold payments claimed by the Contractor on account of incomplete or incorrect invoices or materials that are defective or not in conformance with the contract.

Material Quality

Materials and manufactured products shall be new unless otherwise specified, free from defect, and in conformity with the contract. If there is no applicable standard set forth in this Contract for a particular item, then the item shall be in accordance with industry standards prevailing at the time of bid. The Department has the authority to inspect all Materials and every detail of the Work. The Department may reject the finished product if any of the components do not comply with the specifications. The Department may reject materials not conforming to the Specifications at any time.
