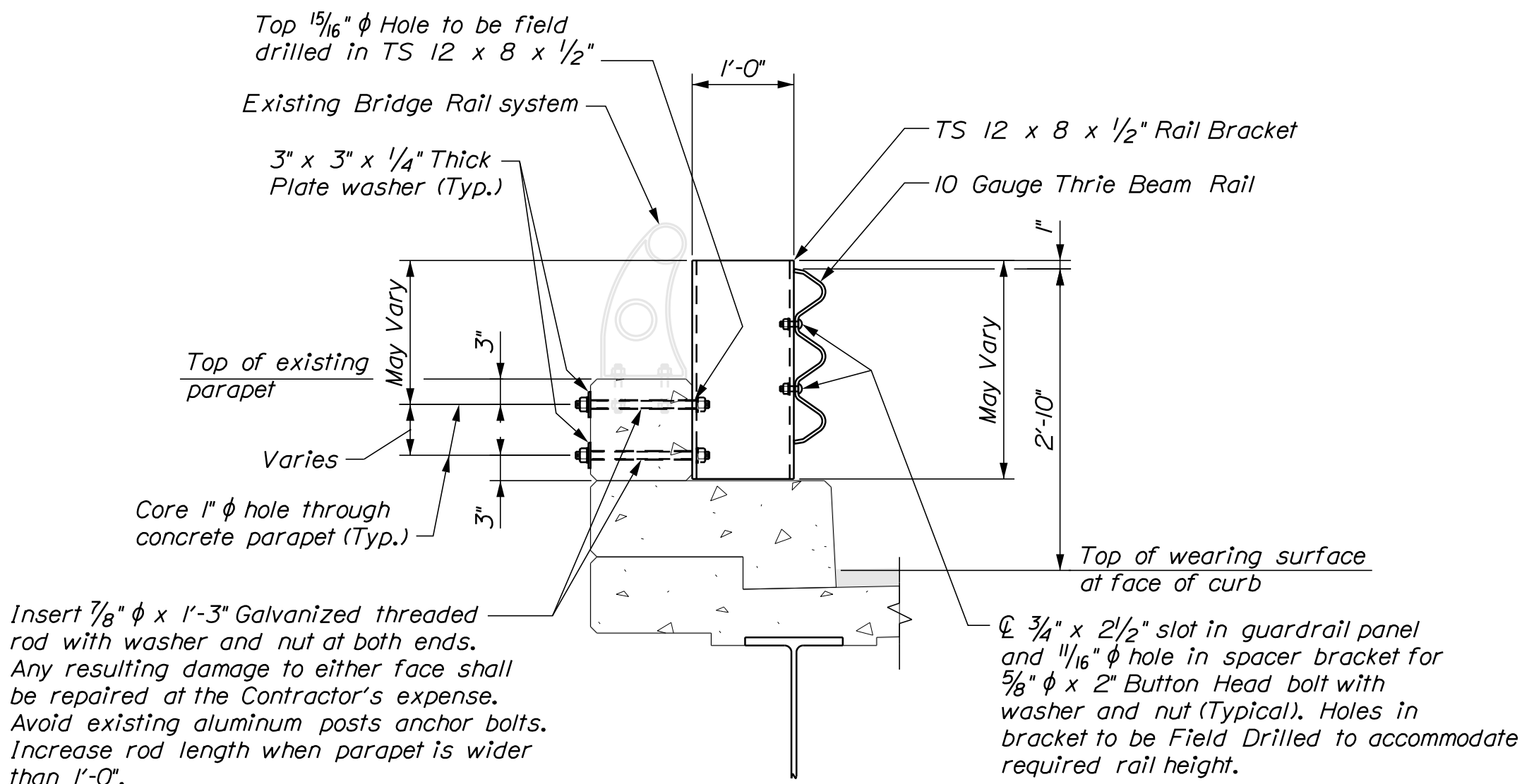
### THRIE BEAM ELEVATION AT CURB

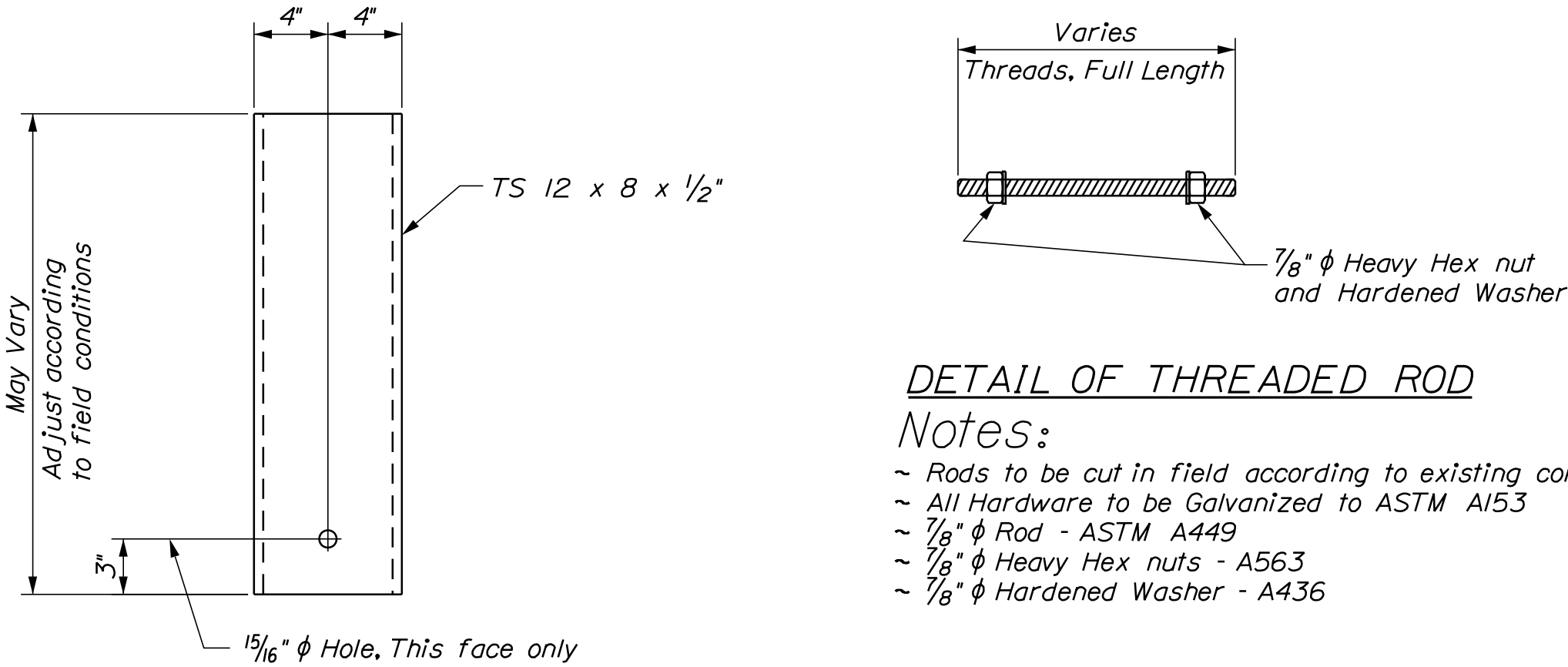

### CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

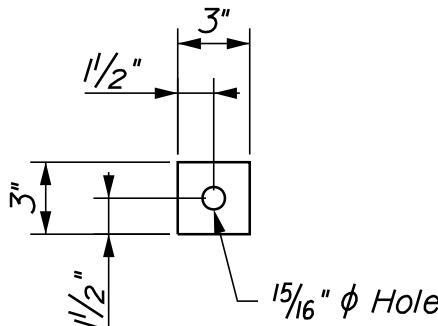
- Additional holes in the Thrie Beam and Type 3 Guardrail panels may be made by drilling, punching or any other method that produces a neat, clean hole of the desired size. Burning of holes will not be allowed. Paint the cut ends of the cut panels and all new holes with an approved CRC cold galvanized. All labor, materials and incidentals needed to complete guardrail modifications shall be considered incidental to guardrail pay items.
- The Contractor shall verify all field dimensions required for fabrication of expansion joints and guardrail items.
- Modifications to new or existing Type 3B Guardrail shall include adding holes as required for conformance to standard details and providing panels of 10 gage thickness. These modifications shall be incidental to Item 606.70 - Transition Section Thrie Beam.
- Threaded rod shall be ASTM A449 or Equal.
- Hardware for threaded rod connections shall be:
  - ~ ASTM A563 for 7/8" Heavy Hex nuts
  - ~ ASTM A436 for 7/8" Hardened washers
  - ~ ASTM A36 for 3" x 3" Plate washers
- All associated hardware, including bolts, threaded rods, washers, nuts and plates shall be Hot Dipped Galvanized after fabrication. Galvanizing shall conform to the requirements of ASTM A153.
- Holes through existing concrete parapet walls for 7/8" threaded rods are to be cored. No drilling of holes will be permitted. Existing reinforcing steel within rail posts shall be located prior to coring by the engineer using a Pacometer.
- Once installation of Thrie Beam is complete, upset threads of all 7/8" rods on each end and paint with CRC cold galvanized.
- All labor, equipment and material necessary to install the Thrie Beam Guardrail shall be incidental to Item 606.73.
- Drilling and anchoring of new anchor bolts for the Thrie Beam rail installation on the bridge shall be done in accordance with Special Provision Section 606 - Thrie Beam - Single Rail Bridge Mounted.
- All existing Bridge Rail shall be removed after installation of new Thrie Beam guardrail and become property of the Maine Department of Transportation. All removed Bridge Rail and posts shall be delivered to MaineDOT Maintenance Camp, 991 Fuller Road, Carmel, ME, per Item 202.134 - Removing Existing Railing (Retained by Department)
- All materials and listed pay item quantities, including lump sum quantities are provided by MaineDOT for informational purposes only.

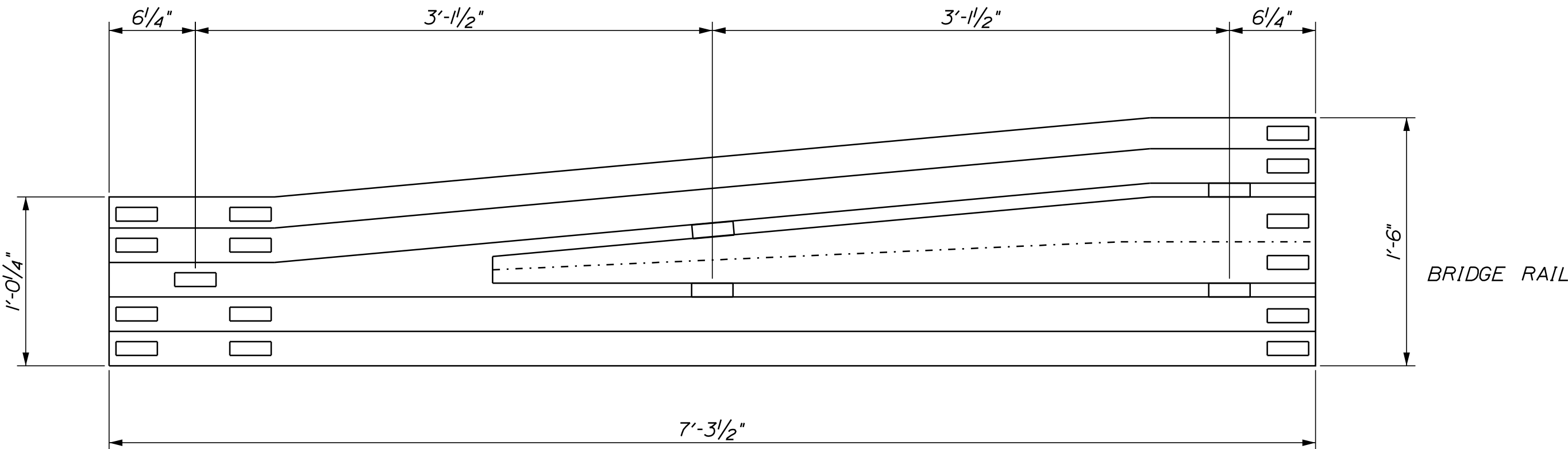
