HEAVY LOAD POSTING

Per Fort Fairfield Town Code, Article VIII – Seasonal Weight Limits, it is unlawful for vehicles exceeding the registered gross weight of 23,000 lbs. to pass over the following roads while they are posted with Heavy Load Limit signs between November 1st and May 1st* of each year.

A permit to cross a posted road may be obtained from Fort Fairfield Public Works by emailing pwdirector@fortfairfield.org or calling (207) 472-3804.

Exemptions: Emergency vehicles, public utilities, municipal vehicles, home heating fuel delivery trucks, bulk potatoes/bulk feed trucks carrying a partial load with a MeDOT Exemption Certificate, or any vehicle or combination of vehicles registered for a gross weight in excess of 23,000 lbs and traveling without a load.

* Heavy Load restrictions may be lifted earlier, dependent on weather conditions.
