

MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
DESCRIPTION OF STATE MAINTENANCE BOUNDARY LINES FOR

Kennebunk, York County, Maine

Beginning at the junction of Emmons Road and Ross Road; thence, easterly to Portland Street (U.S. Route 1) at the Kennebunk-Arundel Town Line; thence southerly along the Kennebunk-Arundel Town Line to Durrell's Bridge Road; thence southerly via the Kennebunk River (Kennebunk-Arundel & Kennebunkport town lines) into the Atlantic Ocean; thence, southwesterly in said ocean, rounding Lord's Point to a point due south of the mouth of the Mousam River; thence, northerly up the Mousam River to a point west of the tidal basin north of Great Hill Road; thence, northeasterly to a point on Western Avenue (State Route 9) 0.23 miles west of the intersection of Sea Road, point of reference utility pole #67A; thence, westerly along the northerly right-of-way of Wells Road (State Route 9) to the Mousam River; thence, northerly via said river to the Boston & Maine-Springfield Terminal Railroad Bridge over said river; thence, southwesterly along the rail line to Fernald Brook; thence, southwesterly to York Street (U.S. Route 1) at the Wells-Kennebunk Town Line at Bridge #2693.

Thence, northerly to intersection of High Street (State Route 9A) and Harriseeket Road; thence, northerly to the Cat Mousam Street (State Route 99) at the Maine Turnpike overpass bridge; thence, northwesterly along the southerly right of way of Cat Mousam Road (State Route 99) to the intersection of Webber Hill Road and Mill St.; thence, northerly along the westerly right of way of Mill Street to Alfred Road; thence easterly along the northerly right of way of Alfred Road to Fletcher St. (State Route 35); thence, northerly along the westerly right of way of Alewife Road (State Route 35) to the intersection of Thomson Road; thence, southeasterly to the junction of Emmons Road and Ross Road, the point of beginning.

Note: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Line are in the rural area.

*updated areas along Mill Street, High St (Rt 9A), Alewife Road (Rt 35), and Whitten Rd
