The definition of roads greater than two lanes is : "Roads with paint-striped pavement for more than two lanes but **not** including shoulders, break down lanes, on-street parking areas, and turning lanes less than 0.03 miles (150 + ft) in length."

^{**} Currently there are 13 municipalities that were eligible to be an urban compact municipality, and had compact area state highway winter maintenance responsibilities on January 1, 1999. All opted out of summer maintenance responsibilities and continue to have winter maintenance responsibilities on compact areas of state highways. That rate is \$1,700 per lane-mile.
