

Notice for Rockland Terminal

The ferry lines are for vehicles actively going on a ferry to an island within a 24-hour period. They are not to be used to avoid paying for parking for vehicles not going on a ferry.

Placing a vehicle in the line means it, or a substitute vehicle, must go on a boat within 24 hours.

Moving a vehicle out of the line, without replacing it with a substitute, means forfeiting its position in line, and receiving a parking violation with a fee of \$25.00.

Any person who leaves a vehicle in line for more than 24 hours (unless the scheduled ferry is cancelled) will be assessed a violation fee and the vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense.

Violators will be assessed a parking violation regardless of the time of year.

Passage aboard MSFS vessels will not be granted until the violation fee is paid.

There is a paid parking lot on premises for your use, at \$17 per day, or fraction thereof.
