The Maine Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Town of Gray, will be conducting an open house to share the current design plans for the Gray Village Transformation Project.

The project includes multiple sections along U.S. and State Routes, including:

- **U.S. Route 202 (West Gray Road & Main Street)**
- **State Route 115 (Yarmouth Road)**
- **State Route 26/100 (Portland Road)**
- Local roads including Shaker Road, Center Road, Brown Street, and Colley Hill Road

Project limits are as follows:

- **U.S. Route 202:** Begins 0.14 miles east of McConkey Road and extends northeast 1.10 miles (just south of Wayne Avenue).
- **State Route 26/100:** Begins at U.S. Route 202 and extends southwest 0.24 miles (terminating adjacent to Gray Plaza).
- **State Route 115 (Yarmouth Road):** Begins at U.S. Route 202 and extends east 0.67 miles (terminating adjacent to Hillcrest Drive).
- **Shaker Road:** Begins at Gray Park Road (southerly end) and extends 0.22 miles to the intersection with U.S. Route 202.

Additionally, new town ways are anticipated as cut-throughs/bypasses to improve access around the village intersections, connecting U.S. Route 202 through Center Road to Route 26/100/4 (Portland Road). Because your property is adjacent to or in proximity to the proposed improvements, you are specifically invited to attend the open house:
