Description of State Maintenance Boundary Lines established for
delimiting the urban area of

Scarborough, Cumberland County, Maine

Scarborough

Beginning at a point on the Scarborough Connector (State Route #701) at the South Portland-Scarborough town line; thence, southeasterly along the said town line to Highland Avenue; thence, southerly along said town line to the Atlantic Ocean; thence southwesterly along the shore line past Scarborough Beach State Park and around Prouts Neck northerly to the confluence of the Scarborough River and the Atlantic Ocean; thence, southwesterly parallel to the shoreline of Pine Point to the Scarborough-Old Orchard Beach town line;

Thence, northwesterly along said town line to the Saco-Scarborough town line; thence, northwesterly along the Scarborough-Saco town line to the east right of way of the Turnpike and then northeasterly along that right of way to Cummings Road; thence northerly along the westerly right of way of Cummings Road to the South Portland city line; thence, southeasterly along the Scarborough and South Portland town lines to the Scarborough Connector (State Route #701), the point of beginning. This effectively makes all roads east of the Maine Turnpike inside the urban compact area, with the exception of Haigis Parkway and SR #701.

Also, the Broadturn Road from US Route 1 northwesterly to a point 0.86 miles north of Holmes Road.

Also, the Beech Ridge Road from the Payne Road northerly to SR #114 (Gorham Road) and then Saco Street to and through a section of Gorham and then easterly to the Westbrook city line.

Also, the Holmes Road from the Payne Road westerly to Beech Ridge Road.

Also, the Gorham Road (SR #114) from the Payne Road northwesterly to the County Road (SR #22).

Also, Running Hill Road from the South Portland city line westerly to the Gorham Road (SR #114).

Also, the County Road (SR #22) from the Westbrook city line westerly to the Gorham townline.

Note: Bridges, if any, bisected by the urban boundary are in the rural area.

*added last section of Highland Avenue to So Portland line, and
added last section of Mussey Road to So Portland town line

** added (Route 77) Spurwink Road 1.1 mile gap and adjusted CUL along shoreline

*** closed gaps on Payne, Beech Ridge, Saco, Holmes, Broadturn, Gorham, & County Roads
