It is with great pleasure that I submit this letter in support of the Maine Department of Transportation’s (MaineDOT) application for funding through the Federal Transit Administration Low or No Emission Grant Program. MaineDOT, in partnership with four Maine transit agencies, is seeking funding for low and no emissions buses for transit service across Maine, including associated infrastructure and staff training and workforce development.

These zero emission vehicles will replace existing diesel vehicles, expanding access to clean and sustainable transportation for thousands of Maine transit riders. The supporting infrastructure includes vehicle chargers necessary for these vehicles to be placed in service, which includes vehicle chargers. Furthermore, the training and workforce development will ensure a skilled, diverse, and sustainable labor pool.

Introducing these vehicles will reduce greenhouse gas emissions, mitigating the impacts of climate change, and directly supports the goals of the state’s climate action plan “Maine Won’t Wait” and corresponding Clean Transportation Roadmap, which calls for continuing to decarbonize Maine’s transportation sector.

I strongly support MaineDOT’s grant application for this important project. I am hopeful that you will give the project your full consideration and award the requested funding.
