Description of State Maintenance Boundary Lines established
for delimiting the urban area of

Windham, Cumberland County, Maine

Beginning at a point on the Raymond town line on Roosevelt Trail (Routes 35/302) thence, southwesterly along the town line to Sebago Lake then southerly along the shoreline to bridge #3857 on Whites Bridge Road, thence southerly along the shoreline to the Standish town line at outlet to Presumpscot River; then southerly along the Standish/Windham town line and then the Gorham/Windham town line to Bridge #5821 on Mallisons Falls Road; thence easterly along the southerly right of way of Mallisons Falls Road to the westerly right of way of River Road; thence southeasterly along the westerly right of way of River Road to the Westbrook town line; thence northeasterly along the Windham/Westbrook town line and then the Windham/ Falmouth town line to the Falmouth Road; thence northerly along the easterly right of way of Falmouth Road to the Gray Road (Routes 202/4) and continuing north to the Gray town line at Tandberg Trail (Route 115); thence southwesterly along the northerly right of way of Route 115 to Brand Road; thence northerly along the easterly right of way of Brand Road and then Smith Road and then due north to the Gray town line at end of Abrahamson Road in Gray; thence northwesterly along the Gray/Windham town line to Mount Hunger Shore Road and then turning south along the westerly right of way of that road to Woodland Road; then turning north and westerly to include Woodland and Richards Roads to Route 302/35 (Roosevelt Trail); thence northerly along the north right of way of Route 302 to Enterprise Drive; thence northerly along the easterly right of way of Enterprise Drive and then due north along a power transmission line to Thrush Terrace; thence northerly around Thrush Terrace and Harvest Hill Road to the Raymond town line and then following that back to Route 302/35 the point of beginning.

NOTE: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Boundary Line are in the rural area.

*updated boundary around Fosters Corner rotary and Routes 202/4; east of Gray Rd.; No. Windham

** closed all gaps on River Rd, Route 302, Falmouth Rd, Rt 115, and Rt 4/202; redrew lines to include most of town due to growth and density of structures
