Augusta Mental Health Institute (AMHI), which opened in October of 1840, was shuttered in 2004. Many of the buildings on the AMHI campus have been renovated into State offices. The few remaining ones, including the old main building, that have not been renovated are posted with no trespassing signs

We realize that the old facility is interesting and unique, and that people are curious about exploring the buildings. However, the State of Maine Division of Property Management has deemed that the buildings that remain empty are hazardous and off limits. Trespassers are subject to arrest and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. No permissions are given to tour the old facilities.
