TOPIC

Canceled - Coding an NFIRS report when the fire department was canceled before responding, while responding, or immediately upon arriving at the scene of the incident

	Canceled en route	Canceled when arrived at the scene	Canceled before leaving the station
Incident Type	611, Dispatched and canceled en route	The appropriate type of situation found: fire, EMS, hazardous condition, etc.	No fire department response; no NFIRS report is completed.
Actions Taken	93, Canceled en route	86, Investigate	
Alarm Date/Time	The date and time the fire department was notified.	The date and time the fire department was notified.	
Arrival Date/Time	There was no arrival; therefore, there was on arrival date/time. Leave both date and time blank.	The date and time the fire department arrived at the scene of the incident.	
Last Unit Cleared Date/Time	The data and time the department was canceled.	The data and time the department's last unit left the incident scene.	

NOTE

- Arriving at a staging area is considered being at a specific location of the incident.
- Fire department personnel must be involved to be considered a response.
- Use of a plus-one code must not change the coding rules.

VALIDATION RULES

Edit No.	Module	Field	Relational Edit
165	Basic	Incident Type	If Incident Type is "611 Canceled en route" then the Property Use and Casualty fields are not required on the Basic Module.
168	Basic	Actions Taken	Generate a user warning message if one of the Basic incident Action Taken codes is 93 (Canceled en route) and the Incident Type is not 611 (Canceled en route).

142	Apparatus	Arrival Time	Arrival Date/Time cannot be earlier than the Alarm Date/Time, the Arrival Date/Time or later than the Clear Date/Time or Last Unit Clear Date/Time. Since there are separate arrival times captured for each piece of apparatus on the Apparatus/Personnel module, the Cleared Time of any unit/apparatus cannot be earlier than the Arrival Time entered on the Basic Module unless the unit/apparatus was canceled en route.
145	Personnel	Arrival Time	Arrival Date/Time cannot be earlier than the Alarm Date/Time, the Arrival Date/Time or later than the Clear Date/Time or Last Unit Clear Date/Time. Since there are separate arrival times captured for each piece of apparatus on the Apparatus/Personnel module, the Cleared Time of any unit/apparatus cannot be earlier than the Arrival Time entered on the Basic Module unless the unit/apparatus was canceled en route.
	Basic	Arrival Date	Valid date if Incident Type does not equal 611, canceled en route
	Basic	Arrival Time	Valid time if Incident Type does not equal 611, canceled en route
