Cancer Reduction Grant Program

Q&A

- Q. Who can apply for the cancer reduction grant program?
- A. Any organized fire department who provides municipal fire protection.
- Q. When can I apply for a grant?
- A. The grant application may be submitted beginning on November 1, 2025 Date, and closes on Jan. 31, 2025.
- Q. How do I submit my completed application?
- A. We strongly encourage submitting via e-mail to Stephan.bunker@gmail.com.
- Q. The application requires a signature of a "Key Official". Who can that be?
- A. A key official can include a City/Town Manager or First Selectman, a person who has financial authority over such actions.
- Q. Can a department apply for both an extractor gear washing machine AND a diesel exhaust system
- A. Yes, but must be submitted on separate applications.
- Q. What is the maximum amount of the grant awards?
- A. For extractor washing machines, it is up to \$5000. For diesel exhaust ventilation systems, the maximum is \$10,000
- Q. How will I know when I have received an award?
- A. Notice of your award or non-award is expected to be made within 30 days of close of the grant application period. We will issue an e-mail to the Applicant and Key Official as soon as the review committee has made its recommendation to the full commission, who has final award authority.
- Q. Can I made a purchase of equipment and then apply for reimbursement thru the program?
- A. No, this is a reimbursement program, Grant funding must be approved prior to the purchase.
- Q. How do I get my grant reimbursement?
- A. After the grant is awarded and the equipment is purchased, submit proof of payment documents to Stephan M. Bunker at Stephan.bunker@gmail.com. The following must accompany your reimbursement request:
- * Copy of the cancelled check/proof of payment or
- * An invoice or warrant record for services rendered marked "PAID".
