**Privacy/Civil Liberties/Civil Rights Audit Report**

**For the Period**

**01 July 2024 – 31 December 2024**

## **INTRODUCTION**

This report accounts for the privacy/civil liberties/civil rights (P/CL/CR) audit conducted by the Maine Information & Analysis Center (MIAC) audit team (Team) for the period of 01 July 2024 through 31 December 2024.

The members of the Team were MIAC Board Member, James Landau; MIAC Board Member, Arnold Shorey; MIAC Director, LT Mathew Casavant; MIAC Deputy Director/MIAC Compliance Officer, SGT Angela Porter; and Assistant Attorney General/MIAC Privacy Officer, Kent Avery. The audit is conducted pursuant to the MIAC Privacy Policy, specifically Part X(3)(B).

## **GENERAL AUDIT PROCESS**

To conduct the audit, the Team followed the “MIAC Privacy Audit Policy.”

As a general note, certain presumptions generally guided the Team in its work. Those presumptions included, for example:

- That, generally, records that are the subject of such audits are commonly understood to be restricted for law enforcement (LE) use only.
- That, generally, records that are the subject of such audits are typically confidential/nonpublic by law, and that their dissemination is therefore restricted by law.
- That, generally, conclusions stated or asserted in records prepared by a LE agency (LEA) are presumed to be factually based.
- That, currently, no records subject to such audits that are maintained in MIAC information technology systems (ITS)-are required by law to be purged.
- That certain databases in which records are maintained or through which records are disseminated (for example, eGuardian) are accessible only by authorized LEAs and LE officers (LEOs).
- That the MIAC Compliance Officer reviews and approves each entry in the MIAC ITS on a weekly – if not daily – basis, that information is reviewed and approved prior to its entry into the eGuardian system, and that all bulletins are peer-reviewed before their dissemination.
- That “personally identifying information” was to be construed broadly for the purposes of question 6 on the Record Evaluation Form, and not to be construed to mean “personal information” (as defined in 10 M.R.S. c. 210-B), which is more narrowly defined.

## **POINTS OF DISCUSSION FOR FURTHER REVIEW WITH THE ADVISORY BOARD**

Points of discussion during the audit that will be further discussed by the Board included:

1. There continued to be discussion on what the “record” is. Questions arose as to whether the MIAC should be evaluated based upon information received by the MIAC and whether opinions of others should be considered a part of the “record.” There was discussion on whether the Privacy Audit Record Evaluation should only be applied specifically to MIAC-produced “records.”
2. There were discussions surrounding whether a report of an antisemitic event’s language surrounding the group should be considered as including a “demographic descriptor” in the record for the purposes of question 11 on the Record Evaluation Form.
3. Discussions on whether a law enforcement report that utilizes the terminology “he” and “she” should be considered as including a “demographic descriptor” in the record for the purposes of question 11 on the Record Evaluation Form.
4. There were some items reviewed during the audit which may have met the qualifications for submitting a Situational Activity Report and therefore could have and possibly should have been entered into the eGuardian system.
5. Concerning question 11 on the Record Evaluation Form, should only the language authored by the MIAC be considered when evaluating the record for demographic, broad, or vague descriptors, or should it be evaluated based on all information, including language and information that was reported to but not authored by the MIAC.

## **CONCLUSION**

- The audit found no evidence of nonconformance by the MIAC with the Center’s Privacy Policy, revised 04 October 2021.
- As in previous audits, the inclusion of three MIAC Advisory Board Members in the P/CR/CL Audit was found to be constructive and beneficial to this process. They provided valuable feedback and engaged in meaningful discussion on a variety of matters relating to P/CR/CL.

As a participant in the February 5, 2025 P/CL/CR audit, I am providing an evaluation of the audit and the audit's findings on the records reviewed.

We followed the current process of selecting records to be evaluated. The records selected for review were distributed to the audit team prior to the audit date with ample time to become familiar with them. The current AUDIT RECORD EVALUATION FORM was completed for each record reviewed. Without having hard statistics, it felt as if this audit utilized the NOTES/COMMENTS box on the form more than in previous audits. These comments were valuable in clarifying decisions made that did not fit neatly into the options available on the standard form. I believe that this is an indication of the care being taken to be true to the spirit of the audit when the form options were too rigid for the complexity on some records.

In my opinion, the MIAC honored their commitment to maintain privacy rights, civil rights, and civil liberties of all individuals referenced in the records reviewed. The records reviewed displayed a conscientious effort to avoid any infringement on privacy rights. As in previous audits that I attended, the audit committee took the time to have longer conversations about any record that required additional understanding.

I sincerely appreciate the opportunity to have been an active participant in this important review process.

Dear Lieutenant Casavant:

Pursuant to MIAC Audit Policy, I am providing my thoughts on the 2024 audit process. I found the MIAC audit process to be thorough, fair and balanced in its evaluation of the MIAC's activities, records, and published bulletins. In addition to randomly selected records and suspicious activity reports, each audit team member chose several records to be examined and evaluated. The Privacy Officer (myself) also chose several records. Including both random selections as well as all suspicious activity reports, and finally items chosen by the MIAC Privacy Officer, allowed for a review that is representative of the entire body of MIAC documents.

The discussion was civil, cordial and candid, but focused on difficult issues dealing with the balance between constitutionally protected speech and the need for civil discourse and public safety. The discussion also raised a couple of issues that will be reviewed by the Advisory Board in the near future. Finally, the fact that the audit team consists of individuals with varying backgrounds and experiences adds value and breadth to the team.

The records we reviewed raised no concerns for the audit team. None of those which initially generated discussion were found to be violative of privacy rights or first amendment speech protections.

Overall, the audit process was efficient but thorough, giving proper attention to individual privacy rights and constitutional protections as well as public safety.
