

Report of Conviction or Misconduct by Law Enforcement, Corrections Officer or Probation Officer

State law requires that in the event that a law enforcement, corrections officer or probation officer is convicted of a crime or engages in conduct that could result in suspension or revocation of the officer's certificate, the chief administrative officer of the agency employing the officer shall expeditiously notify the Director of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy with the name of the law enforcement, corrections officer or probation officer and a brief description of the conviction or conduct. 25 M.R.S. § 2807.
