The Board resolves to withhold its authority to impose discipline against licensees pursuant to 8 M.R.S. § 1003(1)(H) for failing to notify a Department Inspector when required by rule when a Department Inspector is not on site until the amendments to 16-633 C.M.R., Chapter 4 Licensee Records, Chapter 5 and Appendix A, Chapter 6 Ticket Redemption, Chapter 10 Slot Machine Maintenance, Chapter 11 Transportation of Slot Machines and table Games, and Chapter 19 Slot Machine Testing are adopted by the Board and published by the Secretary of State.

When a Department Inspector is not on-site, licensees shall email the director at Milton.f.champion@maine.gov and gambling.control@maine.gov in lieu of notifying a Department Inspector as required until the rules listed above are adopted.
