Brigadier General Don E. Reynolds is assigned as Assistant Adjutant General, Air, Joint Forces Headquarters, Maine. General Reynolds began his military career by joining the Air Force in June 1972. He completed Officer Training in September 1972 at Lackland AFB, Texas.
