1. Informal Review (09:00) - Case 20-152, Applicant present

Disclosure from Tim Beals and Joe Conley that the applicant had previously worked for their services, all parties were comfortable with their continued participation.

Summary 20-152: A Regional Medical Director reported concerns about a Provider's patient care and decision-making capacity. At the time of the complaint the Provider's Paramedic license had expired. The Provider has recently submitted a new licensing application.

 Informal Review (09:45) – Case 20-156; Licensee Present Note: Director Hurley left the meeting prior to the start of this case.

Summary 20-156: Maine EMS received a renewal application with disclosure of a criminal conviction. The conviction does not meet criteria for consideration. The

applicant was actively licensed by Maine EMS at the time of the conviction and failed to report it within 10-days.

MOTION: The Committee made a motion to resolve this case by issuing the renewal with a letter of guidance, citing the importance of adhering to statutory reporting requirements, to be kept on file for four (4) years. 3. Informal Review (10:30) – Case 20-154; Center Representative not present

Summary 20-154: An EMD Center processed 32 emergency calls between December 1, 2020 and December 4, 2020 with an expired EMD Center license.

MOTION: The Committee made a motion to resolve this case by issuing a consent agreement with a warning for unlicensed practice; mitigating circumstances include a high-quality QA program; aggravating circumstances include delayed responsiveness leading up to the renewal, indicating a perceived lack of responsibility to comply with Maine EMS rules, particularly regarding maintenance of an active EMD Center license. (Kellner, seconded Downing) Roll call vote: Gerrish – yes Downing – yes Conley – yes Kellner – yes Beals - yes
