### 7. Old business

- a. Establish the purpose of the committee.
  - Chris Azevedo proposed the goal of the committee: To identify the issues affecting the EMS workforce in Maine, determine the influences on those issues and make recommendations to the EMS Board for developing a plan to address them.

Sam Hurley proposed the committee identify and quantify the root causes facing the EMS labor pool

- b.**Motion** to accept the Chris Azevedo's comment as the purpose of the committee by Brian Chamberlin seconded by Tim Beals.
  - i. Discussion: Brian Chamberlin proposed "to identify the issues negatively affecting recruitment and retention of the EMS workforce in Maine, by gather and synthesize relevant data, and structured engagement of stakeholders and then making recommendations to the EMS Board for developing a plan to address identified issues." Both motion makers were amenable to this change.

- c. Determine a timeline for work goals.
  - Rick stated spring is too early of a deadline and proposed a June deadline to reach the goal of the committee. Seconded by Jay.
     Support from Tim, who first proposed the March deadline. There

was general consensus to have a work product to present at the June board meeting.

d.Increasing stakeholder engagement and involving newer clinicians.

- Brian proposed a structured timeline approach. Giving dates of when each topic would be discussed so the committee can proactively reach out to stakeholders.
- ii. Rick proposed issuing a survey to get input from stakeholders.
  That way the committee can determine which stakeholders to engage based on their survey answers.
- iii. There was discussion of who should be involved in question asking. Largely around if hospital staff should be surveyed or not. Joe Conley proposed we focus on EMS clinicians and expand at a later date, if necessary. Dr. Sholl said there would be benefit in including hospital staff because it would help gain support by demonstrating this is a healthcare systemic problem, not just an issue facing EMS. Rick recommended that external stakeholders have a different survey than the one that's sent out to the internal stakeholders.
- iv. Melissa Adams mentioned using training centers to help get feedback where the TCs already have connections with students. It was stated this would help close the loop on communication.
