Recently there has been some confusion regarding the Staffing Contingencies that are described on page 35 of the Maine EMS COVID-19 Playbook (Version 4.0). The Staffing Contingencies **DO NOT** apply to persons who have received a positive COVID-19 test within the past ten (10) days.

All persons receiving a positive COVID-19 test must observe a ten-day (10) isolation period. The contingency standards may only be applied to persons who are identified as exposures but don't have a positive test.

All symptomatic individuals should receive a COVID-19 test.
