<b>Selects, Checks, and Assembles Equipment</b>				
<b>Delivery</b>				
1. CPAP Device, with small volume nebulizer (SVN) system				
2. Medication (simulated bullet)				
3. Oxygen flowmeter/regulator (2)				
4. Oxygen tank (2)				
5. Oxygen wrench				
<b>Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)</b>				
1. Gloves, eye protection, surgical mask/N95 mask				
<b>Preparation &amp; Safety</b>				
1. Has assessed lung sounds and patient to ensure treatment with BOTH CPAP and nebulized medications is indicated.				
2. Ensures medication rights				
3. Performs medication cross check				
4. Ensures that CPAP device is functioning				
<b>Medication Administration</b>				
1. Dons appropriate PPE – gloves, mask, eye protection. <i>(This is an aerosol generating procedure. COVID-19 precautions should be observed)</i>				
2. Ensures that patient has adequate respirations and airway to use the CPAP and SVN				
a. Patient can follow instructions				
b. Has a patent airway that they can maintain without assistance				
c. Has adequate tidal volume for alveolar gas exchange to occur				
3. Ensures that oxygen tank is assembled and operational				
4. Attaches oxygen tubing <i>(with oxygen off)</i> to flowmeter and SVN cup				
5. Places medication in SVN cup				
6. Ensures that medication cup is sealed and attached to CPAP delivery system				
7. Turns on oxygen to 8-10 LPM and ensures that medication is “misting”				
8. Instructs the patient to sit up straight <i>(if possible)</i> , place the delivery system in-line with CPAP system, and continue inhaling and exhaling as the medication is delivered
