 - i. Dr. Lowry presented the plan for this meeting to review the Scope of Practice Document
 - ii. Sam shared some of his thoughts
 - iii. Heather Pelletier shared that when there is a screening, they also want to see a referral and connect to a care management

service that can do the care management in the long term, not to supplant case management.

- iv. We discussed sending the information back to the referring physician
- v. Walter wanted to emphasize case management is done on a case-by-case basis. Some may be transitional; some may be longer term.
- vi. Ellen added her wish to reinforce Dennis's point of communicating with primary care providers and referring clinicians.
- vii. Sam- Is there value in adopting a standard screening tool?
 - 1. This can and should be standardized and validated in our documentation system
 - 2. Review what the larger hospital systems are using.
- viii. Anything that is part of the plan of care would be seen as chronic care management and part of CP and the education.
 - ix. There was a discussion about payment for training and evaluation of durable medical equipment. There can be a contract between an EMS CP Agency, and a DME supplier to complete the deployment of the equipment and supply the use of the equipment education.
