- a. Scope of Practice Discussion
 - i. Discussed removal of iStat from glossary as it is not present throughout the document
 - ii. Group discussed DME and how that relates to billing and delegated practice versus EMS practice. Based on that discussion committee decided to change phrasing to equipment assessment.
 - iii. Dr. Sholl discussed the importance of ensuring that CP MOUD works in concert with other Maine EMS MOUD responses.
 - iv. Group discussed creating a formulary with a specific list of acceptable classes of medications.
 - 1. The formulary will act as a companion document and can begin in the committee and then be sent to the MDPB committee.
 - 2. The formulary allows for footnotes for immunizations, medications, vaccinations etc.
 - v. Committee moved vaccine administration to the procedure section.
 - vi. Committee decided upon a language change around wound care to sub-acute and chronic wound management to better differentiate the role of a CP versus a current EMS scope.
 - vii. Group started a discussion around Non-CLIA waived point of care testing.
