EMS is a critical component of the health care delivery model. With ~300K EMS activations per year occurring in Maine the data collected is a valuable asset. Some of the reasons this is so and why complete and accurate documentation of patient encounters with the patient care report (PCR) are:

- The patient medical record: A patient's PCR becomes part of a patient's permanent medical record and serves as a valuable resource to- those who are providing continuing and future care to the patient. A complete and accurate report allows for the patient to receive better future care and reduces the risk that such care could negatively impact the patient.
- A legal record: A PCR serves as a legal document, or a record of fact, for the interaction with a patient. A complete and accurate report provides for protection to you, your agency, and your community.
- Justification for billing and reimbursement: The PCR provides for documentation of the services and treatments
 provided to the patient and justification for those services and treatments. A complete and accurate report
 provides for easier reimbursement and also as an explanation should questions arise in the reimbursement
 process.
- For improvements to care: Analysis of the data captured in a PCR is able to identify opportunities with care provided where the effectiveness of the care is able to be improved where the standard of care or protocols are modified
- Problem solving: Analysis of the data captured in a PCR is able to identify underlying causes of problems occurring within the EMS system.
- Supporting evidence for research: Analysis and sharing of the data captured in a PCR serves as a great research tool for numerous research topics. Maine EMS provides analysis and sharing for numerous research requests.
- Supporting evidence for grant and community funding: Analysis and sharing of the data captured in a PCR is
 used to support grants awarded to the State, Counties, City(ies)/Towns and community organizations. While the
 dollar amount is not known, it is believed that analysis and sharing of data by Maine EMS is in support of grants
 measured in the millions of dollars each year.

Accurate, complete, and timely patient care reports are **legally** and **ethically** required of EMS practitioners. There are several reasons why documenting a patient care report in a timely manner are important:

- As part of the patient record, EMS patient care reports play an important role in the continuum of patient care. Both sending and receiving medical facilities are able to view patient care reports once they have been entered to review the care provided allow for better and more informed determinations in ongoing care decisions.
- There are several real-time interfaces with MEFIRS that are used for syndromic surveillance and risk management. Delays in reporting result in delays in other notification and alerting systems.
- A patient care report is considered a record of fact. As the duration of time between when care is provided and
 the care is documented the patient care report is likely to become less complete, less accurate, and less reliable
 as a record of fact.

Methodology: The time to finish a patient care report (PCR) is identified by the duration of time between the time the unit is notified by dispatch and the time the PCR is marked as finished or signed by the primary caregiver. Outliers where identified as those records being more than one standard deviation from the mean, resulting in 2,723 (0.92%) of the 296,766 records being excluded, having an hours to complete value greater than 168 hours (7 days). Also excluded are 15,958 EMS activations that have no marked as finished date/time nor a signature date/time resulting in an inability to calculate the time to complete the report.

Key points of the following visualizations include:


- The majority (97%) of PCRs are completed within the required 24 hours
- Timeliness improves with volume
- Agencies averaging less than one (1) EMS activation per day have the highest non-compliance levels
- No discernible differences were noted in time to complete for Type of Service Requested, Hour of Day, Day of Week, nor Month

Some of the following data is presented in a box plot chart, a format which provides a significant amount information. Key components of the box plot are:


- The minimum value is represented by the lowest horizontal bar for each series
- The maximum value is represented by the highest horizontal bar for each series
- The mean value is represented by a solid horizontal line foreach series
- The median value is represented by a dashed horizontal line for each series
- The 25th percentile value is represented by the bottom of the box area for each series
- The 90th percentile value is represented by the top of the box area for each series


Notes:

- The top and bottom 1% of records have been removed from the calculations as a method to reduce inclusion of data entry errors.
- Not all agencies document all times. In cases where a time to complete value cannot be calculated the EMS Activation is not included in the analysis.




Compliance For All Patient Care Reports







Agency Count By Percent Compliance














Time To Complete By Type Of Service





Time To Complete By Organization Status








