- 1. Chapter 3 Revisions Review by Committee
  - a. Committee reviewed and discussed revisions creating a service requirement for a driver/operator training program
  - b. Added to §7(7) "...licensed by Maine EMS..."
  - c. Added under §7(7)(A)(2) a section that requires the policy on Emergency Vehicle Response to reference selected definitions in Chapter 2
  - d. Removed §7(7)(C)(b)(iii)
  - e. Added a provision making §7(7) effective 6 months after publication of rule
  - f. Added to §3(1) "...or the removal of a 9-1-1 Primary Response Area, on a renewal application form."
  - g. Added to §2(6) language permitting the licensure of a service without a 9-1-1 Primary Response Area and clarifying expectations of a service in its response to a scene location for an Emergency Medical Call.
  - h. Revised §4(2) to better reflect criteria the Board would use to determine need.
  - i. Struck §4(2)(G)
  - j. Added to  $\S5(1)(C)(1)$  "...for interfacility transport operations only."
  - k. Revised §5(1)(D) to better reflect information an applicant should submit to support their proposed en-route times, response times, transport times, and time tolerances.
