- 2. Mission Statement
 - a. Dr. Lowry read the mission statement.

- 5. Approval of Meeting Minutes

- 6. Office Update

- a. RFA Update Soliana
 - 1. Soliana provided an update on the RFA process. Conditional awards have gone out and the office is in the midst of the contracting process. The office also anticipates an RFP going live in the near future that focuses on the development of educational standards of community paramedicine.

7. Old Business

- a. Draft concept rules
 - 1. Soliana provided an update that any documents incorporated by reference within a rule would need to go through the formal rules process should they want a change.
 - 2. The committee reviewed the entire document in full and focused on transition plans for both personnel and agencies.
 - 3. The committee discussed what an unrestricted license means.
 - 4. Walter discussed the importance of ensuring there is enough time to transition that does not create a gap in service.
 - 5. Ellen clarified that different theoretical license levels would have different educational requirements and the pathway of transition for people currently practicing will ensure no gaps in service.
 - 6. Dr. Lowry discussed that the goal is to be able to utilize existing education when feasible.
 - 7. Dennis discussed that some agencies may not need as long to transition some may need 6 months versus 36 months.
 - 8. The committee discussed what the Maine Background Check Center could look like in practice.
 - 9. Dr. Busko brought up a concern about the requirement for 50 calls to maintain agency licensure.
 - 1. The committee discussed at length worries about agencies meeting this requirement or gatekeeping service and chose to strike this requirement.
 - 10. Dennis motioned to recommend this concept document to be sent to the rules subcommittee for consideration. Second by Charlie. Unanimous approval.
