Effective Tuesday, May 27, 2025, Northern Light Inland Hospital in Waterville officially closes all ED and clinical services.

Northern Light Inland Hospital is no longer an EMS destination

Maine General – Thayer Campus (149 North Street, Waterville) is located in Waterville and is an approved destination for EMS (and is a stand-alone ED 3 miles from NL-Inland)
